## **Baker Doubles October 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup>, 2004**

The next CBA tournament will be the ever-popular Baker Doubles and will be held at Minnehaha Lanes located at 955 Seminary Ave, St Paul MN. Traveling on Hwy 94 take the Lexington Ave exit and go north. The 2<sup>nd</sup> stop light past University Ave is Minnehaha Ave, turn right and the lanes are 2 blocks down and in back of the shopping center on the left. Our host is manager and CBA member Dutch Erkenbrack. This 40-lane center features a full bar & restaurant, game room and pull-tabs.

### **Baker System Doubles Format**

We will be bowling 16 baker games for qualifying. There will be 2 baker teams per lane. Leadoff bowler bowls the odd frames and the anchor bowler bowls the even frames (including the 10<sup>th</sup> frame). You decide at the start of each game who will bowl leadoff or anchor. You bowl the entire game on the lane you are assigned. After the first game the teams that started on the left lane will move left for the entire day and the teams that started on the right lane will move right for the entire day. After 8 games we will break for a buffet lunch, which will be available for all bowlers & spectators. You will bowl the 9<sup>th</sup> game on the same pair as the 8<sup>th</sup> game but you will bowl on the opposite lane and then keep moving the same way you were.

## **HALL OF FAME BANQUET**

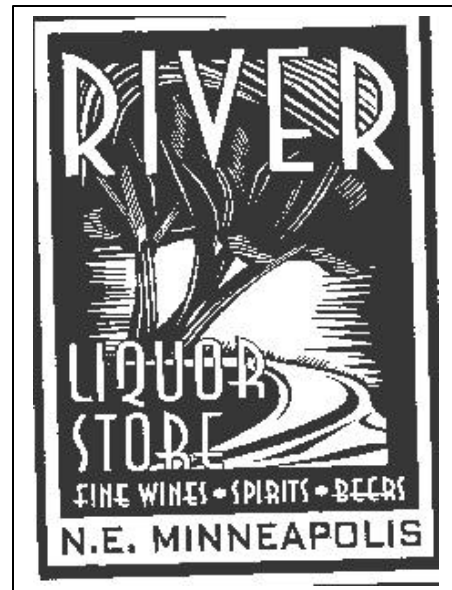

### **Reduced Entry**

## Bob Micek (“The Duck”) Waddles to Victory at Garden Center Lanes

Affectionately nicknamed “**The Duck**”, **Bob Micek** took care of business when he had to for his 3<sup>rd</sup> CBA title. Leading after the first cut of 8 games with a score of 1779 (222 avg), 2<sup>nd</sup> after the 2<sup>nd</sup> cut of 3 more games, and after 3 more games Micek was seeded 2<sup>nd</sup> going into stepladder finals. **Arnie Gerdes** had vaulted into the top spot after the 14 games of qualifying with a score of 2925 (208 avg) and was trying to win the CBA tournament in his hometown. Gerdes had a little trouble on the right lane as he opened the 2<sup>nd</sup> and could only manage 2 spares on that lane as he didn’t miss on the left. Micek took advantage by having 2 doubles in the match while staying clean to win 213-192 and his 3<sup>rd</sup> CBA Title. Micek was only 1 week out of the Mayo clinic with chemotherapy treatments before the tournament.

The first stepladder match had 3 bowlers squaring off to advance, **Brad Larson, John Kreyer Jr and Brent Prentice**. Larson took care of them with a 299 game while Kreyer Jr had 245 and Prentice 202. Larson went on to meet the 11 game Qualifying Leader, **Daron Hansen**, who had shot a 300 earlier. Both bowlers started slow but a clean game by Larson had him moving on 213-178. Larson, however, ran into trouble and Micek took care of him 232-179.

**Jason Barnhouse** won the “On Track Cashier” rolloff for a free entry into the November tournament. High game out of the money was a 265 by **Keith Howard** and Hansen’s Qualifying Leader score was 2345 (213 avg).

The CBA would like to thank the **Meyer Family** for hosting our tournament and we look forward to having next years’ tournament at the new Garden Center location. **Charlie Meyer** hopes to have everything in place by August 2005.
