### **Todd Savoy Elected to ABC Hall of Fame**

Five-time American Bowling Congress Championships Tournament champion Todd Savoy of Superior, Wis. was elected into the ABC Hall of Fame during Hall of Fame Board meetings recently held in Milwaukee.

Savoy, 45, was elected from the non-pro ballot and is one of bowling's most prolific team players earning five team titles while averaging 214.2 for 22 tournaments, second among active players. He was a member of the Minnesota Loons teams that won the 1984 team and team all events, 1985 team all-events and 1988 team titles. Bowling with Linds Lakers, he also won the 2002 team all events title.

His prowess as a team competitor carried over to international competition where he won gold medals in the five-player and trio events and a bronze in doubles in the 1985 Federation Internationale des Quilleurs American Zone Championships in Bogota, Colombia.

“All I can say is wow,” Savoy said when notified of his election into the Hall. “Since most of my titles came in team competition, I have been very fortunate to be surrounded by great bowlers who made me a better player. I couldn't have achieved what I have without them.”

CBA Logo patches will be available at all tournaments. All members & non-members must have a CBA logo displayed on their shirt or they must purchase a patch for \$7.00. All bowlers must have their names and CBA logos on their shirts for both days and no bowlers are allowed to wear jeans on Sundays. A \$10.00 fine will be issued for bowlers late for paddock on Sunday. Paddock is always at 7:40 AM.

### **CBA Sweeper on Friday Nov 19th at 9:00 PM**

The CBA will run a sweeper on Friday night before the tournament. It is open to all bowlers and the cost is only \$35.

Format as follows:

1. Bowl 3 games across 6 lanes
2. Cost: \$35 (expenses \$10 – prize fund \$25)
3. After 3 games, field will be cut to the top 16 bowlers who will bowl a single elimination match play.
4. Prize money: Based on 60 entries. 1<sup>st</sup> place \$300, 2<sup>nd</sup> place \$150, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> \$125 each, 5<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> \$80 each, and 9<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> \$60 each.

## Dan Bock and Chad Nelson are Victorious at the Baker Doubles

**Dan Bock** and **Chad Nelson** had an advantage at the CBA Baker Doubles tournament that nobody knew about . They grew up practicing in Owatonna on the tough inside shot that was at Minnehaha Lanes and became pretty good at it (of course they are pretty good on other conditions also). They had to face a veteran team of **Scott Pohl & Arnie Gerdes** for the championship who were the leaders going into the stepladder. In the first game Pohl/Gerdes had a turkey and five-bagger for a 256 to Bock/Nelson's 220. Then Pohl/ Gerdes ran into trouble on the left lane as they 2 opens in the first 5 frames and an open in the 8<sup>th</sup>. Bock/Nelson had an early open but covered it by staying clean through the 8th to cut into the 36 pin lead. Astrike by Bock in the 9<sup>th</sup> set up Nelson to get the 1<sup>st</sup> strike in the 10<sup>th</sup> to win 413-397 and their first doubles title together. Pohl/Gerdes were 2<sup>nd</sup> for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year-in-a-row.

In the first stepladder match Bock/Nelson went up against the team of **Carl Fietek** and **Brent Prentice**. Bock/Nelson shot 247 to Fietek/Prentice's 200 in the first game and took the 2 game match 442-389. Next up was the other Owatonna duo of **David & Dan Langer**. Bock/Nelson proved to be too much as they shot 235-253 for 488 to Langer/Langer's 400. Next up were newly CBA Hall of Fame inductee **Brad Larson** and partner **Dave Bordson**. Bock/Nelson were clean their first game for 198 to Larson/Bordson's 192. An early double and late four-bagger in the 2<sup>nd</sup> game gave Bock/Nelson the victory 432-407.

The Qualifying Leader honors went to **Todd Savoy** and **Gary Green** with a score of 3372 for the 16 baker games (210 average). It took a score of 3159 (197 avg) to make the cut and 3135 (195 avg) to cash. Hall of Famers **Clark Poelzer** and **Al Loth** took the Bonus senior cash spot at 3114 (194 avg) and **Lisa Duenow & Kris Geister** took the bonus woman cash spot at 2972.

Saturday night's Hall of Fame and awards banquet was awesome as we inducted 2 members into our Hall of Fame. **Jeff Lind** of the Linds Shoe Company was inducted for Meritorious Service and Brad Larson for Superior Performance. We also honored the award winners of the past season and drew 3 names for the River Liquor Store Year-End shootout. They are **Daron Hansen, Loren Lickfelt and Richard Vitko**.

Special thanks to **Dutch Erkenbrack & Mike Cowan** for hosting the tournament & banquet and for putting out the tough shot we wanted to see.
