One Squad - Paddock: 8:30 AM - Bowling: 9:00 AM

Format: 8 games of qualifying match play with 10 bonus pins per match with the top 8, 12 or 16 (depending on entries) making the cut. They will then bowl standard match play with 30 bonus pins per match. If 8 qualify we will bowl 7 standard rounds and 1 position round. If 12 qualify we will bowl 5 games with 4 per pair and 1 position round. If 16 qualify we will bowl 7 games with 4 per pair and 1 position round. There will be no stepladder finals and all pins will carry over. 35 or less entries top 8, 36-47 entries top 12 and 48-59 entries top 16 will make the cut.

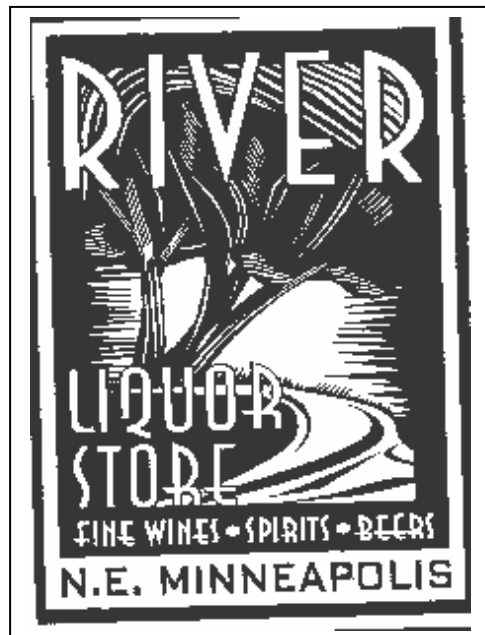

Lee Stritesky Wins 1st CBA Title at Country Lanes North

Lee Stritesky has bowled in many CBA tournaments, starting in the 80's, did a lot of practicing and it finally paid off for him as he won his 1st CBA title. Stritesky qualified 8th after the 8 games of match play qualifying with a score of 1863 (232 avg) and won 5 of his 8 matches for 50 bonus pins. Going into the position round Stritesky was in 3rd place 2 pins behind **Scott Pohl** and 36 pins behind leader **Carl Fietek**. Bowling against **Ron Kish** in the final match Stritesky shot 279 to Kish's 245 while Pohl took care of Fietek 247 to 180. **David Bordson** moved from 7th to 3rd with a 241 in the position round Stritesky needed the first strike in the 10th to win and calmly did and was rewarded for all the bowling & practicing and dedication to the sport and the CBA.

Carl Fietek has pretty much locked up another Bowler of the Year title as he finished in the top 5 again and is on pace to set a points record which he set a couple years ago. Fietek has bowled in 11 tournaments and has been in the top 5 in 10 of them and didn't cash in the other. Awesome!!!! Ron Kish, another bowler dedicated and who hasn't given up, made the cut for the 3rd consecutive tournament and his first top 5 finish. Kish took advantage of the CBA's \$75 entry until you cash program and bowled all the tournaments in the last 2 years.

Pat Umphrey was the Qualifying Leader with a score of 1937 (242 avg) plus 60 bonus pins for a total of 1997 to **Daron Hansen's** 1933 (241 avg) plus 60 bonus pins. Hansen started the day with 300-299-255=854. Other honor scores were 299's by **Brad Larson** and **Luke Voaklander**. **Jeff Dempich** won the rolloff for the "*On Track Casher*" while it took a score of 1785 (223 avg) to make the top 12.
