**Membership fee is \$40.00 and is due now unless you are bowling for the 1<sup>st</sup> time. Must be a member and have bowled in 4 tournaments during the season to be eligible for the Added Money Year-End tournament in May.**

Brackets are still available for \$10.00 each.

The optional \$35.00 prize list will be paid out after qualifying scores at 1 for 3 ratios. You actually don't have to cash in the tournament to cash in the optional prize list.

**Bowlers making the cut ratio will be changed to 1 for 3.**

24 bowlers – 8 make the cut  
30 bowlers – 10 make the cut  
36 bowlers – 12 make the cut  
42 bowlers – 14 make the cut  
48 bowlers – 16 make the cut  
54 bowlers – 18 make the cut  
60 bowlers – 20 make the cut  
66 bowlers – 22 make the cut  
72 bowlers or more – 24 make the cut

Cut numbers will depend on lanes available for match play. For example: bowling in a 20 lane house with 66 or more bowlers only 20 will make the cut.

## Carl Fietek Wins 13<sup>th</sup> CBA Title – Takes Bowler of the Year Lead Again

**Carl Fietek** showed once again his dominance of the CBA Bowler of the Year Award. After finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> in the June tournament at AMF Maple Lanes he was in 2<sup>nd</sup> place behind **Sam Lantto**. This didn't sit too well with him so he decided to take charge and win the July CBA at Minnehaha Lanes and take an 11 point lead over **Dan Bock**. The championship match between Fietek and Bock came down to the 10<sup>th</sup> frame with Fietek finishing first by going 9 spare 9 with both leaves being 10 pins. Bock needed the first strike and threw a tremendous shot but left the 4-7-9 split, he converted and then struck but Fietek had a 226-225 victory and his 13<sup>th</sup> CBA title. Fietek is the reigning Bowler of the Year for the last 2 seasons, with last year an all time record for points, and now has 7 B.O.Y. titles and looking for number 8.

The first stepladder match had **Luke Voaklander** up against **Bryan Thelen** (making his first stepladder appearance). A couple opens had Thelen behind early and Voaklander cruised to a 202-162 win. Senior **Tom Korth** took care of Voaklander 183-182 when Voaklander could only manage 7 on his count ball. Teammates Korth and Bock were up next and although Korth came on strong at the end Bock had him shut out in the 10<sup>th</sup> for a 198-195 victory to move into the title match.

**Dan Bock** was the Qualifying Leader with an actual score of 1655 (206 avg) plus 70 bonus pins for 1725. **Brent Prentice** and **Jason Barnhouse** tied for 15<sup>th</sup> and last cash at minus 46 with bonus pins and had to have a 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame rolloff for the last cash spot. Prentice struck all 4 times for 1 60-36 victory and sent Barnhouse into the On Track Casher rolloff. Barnhouse didn't participate in the rolloff as he will be on his honeymoon for the next tournament, so we drew another name and **Chad Nelson** won the rolloff for the free entry into the August tournament. **Lisa Noor** won the bonus woman cash spot with minus 74 including bonus pins.

A special thanks to **Dutch Erkenbrack** of Minnehaha Lanes for hosting our tournament and Head Mechanic **Mike Cowan** who did it all to make sure the CBA was a success.
