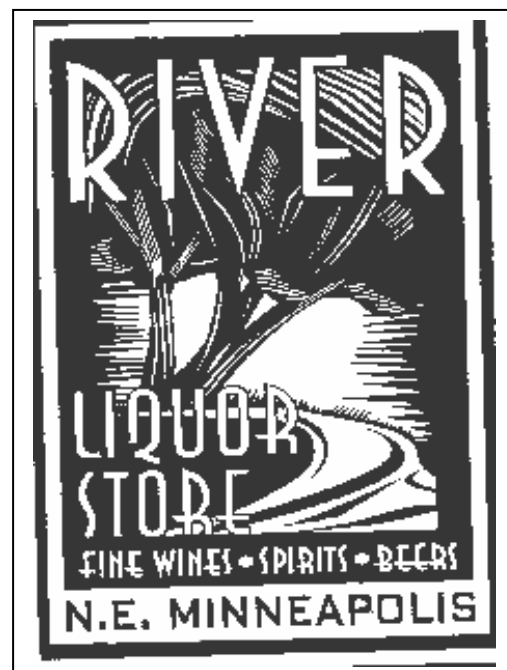

## Clark Poelzer is Bowler for the Decades as he wins at Garden Center Lanes

When **Clark Poelzer** won the CBA at the “NEW” Garden Center Lanes in Alexandria he became the Bowler of the Decades. He joined **John Eiss, Dave Hoppenrath, Sam Lantto, Todd Savoy, Jeff Smith** and **Chuck Vashaw** by winning in three different decades but he became the first bowler to win while in his 20’s, 30’s, 40’s and 50’s. With his first title coming in August 1980 at Midway Pro Bowl, Clark now has eight career CBA titles and is the only bowler to win over \$5000 in a single CBA season.

56 bowlers entered the tournament and we took the top 18 to Sunday’s match play. After 6 games of match play Poelzer was only 29 over and in 16<sup>th</sup> place. He then proceeded to win 5 of the next 6 matches while averaging 244 to take the 3<sup>rd</sup> position in the stepladder. The first stepladder match had current point’s leader **Dan Bock** against Hall of Famer **Scott Pohl**. A couple of splits for Pohl, one coming in the 9<sup>th</sup> left the door open for Bock as he cruised 259-222. Bock had a little carry trouble in the next match but a big 4 in the 9<sup>th</sup> gave Poelzer the match 237-213. The next match had Poelzer against the CBA’s best Garden Center bowler in **Chad Nelson**. Nelson started the match with the “full soddy” but picked it up and stayed clean through the 7<sup>th</sup>, while Poelzer had back-to-back splits in the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> frames and Nelson had a 6 pin lead in the 8<sup>th</sup>. With both bowlers striking in the 9<sup>th</sup>, Nelson needed to double in the 10<sup>th</sup> to shut out Poelzer, but only managed the first one and Poelzer came through with his double to win 194-190 and move on to the championship match. Another Hall of Famer and 7 time CBA bowler of the year, **Carl Fietek** was up next. In a battle of the two Hall of Famers it turned out to be an easy match as Fietek had some trouble and Poelzer took his 8<sup>th</sup> CBA title by a score of 202-145.

It took an average of 204 to cash and make the cut and **Jason Barnhouse** led the qualifying with 2249 (224 avg). **Tom Korth** and **Ron Lindner** won the bonus senior cash spots while **Karyn Beckjorden** won the bonus woman casher. **Steve Bohn** won the rolloff for the “On Track Casher” and a free entry into the November CBA. Congratulations to **Jason Smith** and **Mike Bischoff** for making the cut for the first time.

A huge thank you to the Meyer family for hosting our tournament at the NEW bowling center. **Matt Meyer** won the Friday night sweeper as 24 bowlers came up to bowl. A great time was had by all and we look forward to next year.
