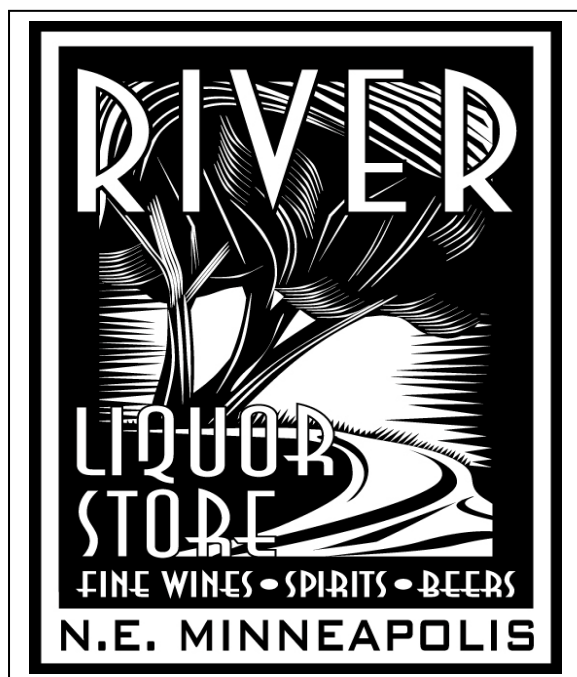

## John Kreyer Jr and Adam Kittelson Triumph in the Baker Doubles at Cedarvale

**John Kreyer Jr** and **Adam Kittelson** battled all day during Sunday's match play and came on strong in the last couple matches to take the 2<sup>nd</sup> spot in the stepladder. When they got to the championship match all that was waiting for them were the hottest bowlers in the CBA and the defending champs **Dan Bock & Chad Nelson**. As good as they were bowling they had all the confidence they could take the title, and by starting the first game with the front ten for 289 to Bock/Nelson's 214, they felt pretty good. The 2<sup>nd</sup> game of the 2 game total pins match had Kreyer/Kittelson with 227 for 516 to Bock/Nelson's 224 for 438 and the Baker Doubles Championship. It is the 4<sup>th</sup> CBA title for Kreyer and 1<sup>st</sup> for Kittelson while Bock/Nelson took 2<sup>nd</sup> for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time.

The first stepladder match had 3 time champions **Daron Hansen** and **Chuck Vashaw** against the brother duo of **David & Dan Langer**. A 279 first game for Hansen/Vashaw propelled them to a 515-424 win. Next up were past doubles champions **Brian Floen and Rob Downer**. Hansen/Vashaw struggled in the 2<sup>nd</sup> game and Floen/Downer had an easy win 492-397. Floen/Downer seemed to have no chance in the next match as they lost 534-432 to Kreyer/Kittelson to set the stage for the championship match.

Qualifying Leaders were newly inducted CBA Hall of Famer **Jeff Smith** and **Rod Neuenschwander** with a score of 3757 (234 avg). The cut score was 3504 (219 avg) and cashing was 3471 (216 avg). **Brad Larson** and **Dave Bordson** shot a 300 on Saturday and Hansen/Vashaw had 300 on Sunday while **Matt Floen** and **Chad Behnken** had a 299 on Saturday. CBA Hall of Famers **Jim Lindquist** and **Roger Blad** took the bonus senior cash spot with 3424 and **Deb Lantto** and **Diane Marget** had 3358 for the bonus woman cash spot.

The Hall of Fame and Awards banquet was a big success as **Jeff Smith** was inducted for Superior Performance. We also honored all the champions from the past season along with the All Star teams, John Dorek award, Jim Lindquist award and the Bob Hanson Sportsmanship award. We drew 3 names for spots in the River Liquor Store Year End shootout and the winners were **Dustin Barr, Ron Kish** and **Pat Umphrey**.

A huge thank you to **Brent Prentice** and **Craig McDonald** for their hospitality in hosting the tournament and banquet.
