Change to the On Track Casher Rolloff

Due to the popularity of the “On Track Casher” and bowlers suggesting ways to get more bowlers involved, we will use the new format at Holiday Lanes. All non cashers will be invited to participate if they wish. We will have everyone bowl either one shot and if you don’t strike you’re out or we might do a 9th & 10th frame and half the field will advance. It all depends on the lanes and time available.

Unusual Leave

Jason Barnhouse was all even for 1 frame during qualifying. He took out the 1-3-5-7-9 on his first ball leaving only the 2-4-6-8 and 10 pins.

CBA Logo patches will be available at all tournaments. All members & non-members must have a CBA logo displayed on their shirt or they must purchase a patch for \$7.00. All bowlers must have their names and CBA logos on their shirts for both days and no bowlers are allowed to wear jeans on Sundays. A \$10.00 fine will be issued for bowlers late for paddock on Sunday. Paddock is always at 7:40 AM.

Only 3 more tournaments left to qualify for the Big Added Money Year End CBA!!

The 2005-2006 Year End CBA will be held at AMF Maplewood Lanes in Maplewood. Bowlers must be a member for this season and have bowled in 4 tournaments to be eligible. The payout will be 1 for 2 and there will be approximately \$4000 Added Money for this tournament.

River Liquor Store Year End Shootout

River Liquor Store is again sponsoring the Shootout with a \$500 donation and another \$500 will be added from the bracket proceeds. 13 bowlers will compete in the shootout. Last Years’ champion, Tim Hoke and 3 bowlers who had their names drawn at the Hall of Fame banquet, Dustin Barr, Ron Kish and Pat Umphrey, will be entered and 9 more bowlers will be added by drawing from the non cashers at the Year End tournament. The bowlers already entered into the shootout must have 4 tournaments in to be eligible.



Luke Voaklander Wins at Midway Pro Bowl for 2nd CBA Title

Luke Voaklander looked like he was on cruise control during the match play of the CBA tournament at Midway Pro Bowl. Qualifying 5th in the 8 game match play qualifying, Voaklander started the 6 game match play with a 262 and took the 90 bonus pins to jump towards the top. Voaklander had to face **Richard Vitko** in the position round for the top spot in the stepladder, and a 201 to 187 win by Voaklander gave him the top spot. Voaklander started the championship match with a four bagger while Vitko had a double-spare-strike-spare. A late turkey by both bowlers had Voaklander with a 19 pin lead in the 9th frame. Only needing a mark, Voaklander calmly picked up the 4-pin for a 247-235 victory and his 2nd CBA title.

The stepladder started with soon to be Hall of Famer **Chad Nelson** against Hall of Famer **Al Loth**. A five bagger by Nelson took care of Loth 221-184. Nelson moved on to face **Pat Umphrey** in a match that was tough for both bowlers as Umphrey won 178-168. Umphrey had more trouble in the next match as he only managed a 148 to Vitko's 204. Vitko went on to face Voaklander for his first chance at a CBA title.

Qualifying Leader was **Pat Umphrey** with a score of 1718 (214 avg) plus 60 bonus pins for a total of 1778. It took a score of 1510 (188 avg) plus 60 bonus pins for 1570 to make the cut and 1497 (187 avg) plus 40 bonus pins for 1537 to cash. **Matt Kirkham** won the eliminator rolloff for the "On Track Casher" and a free entry into the CBA at Holiday Lanes.

We would like to thank Midway Pro Bowl proprietors **Al Loth** and **Scott Koecheler** for their hospitality in hosting yet another CBA event. Proprietors like this make the CBA a great organization.
