Only 1 more tournament left to qualify for the Big Added Money Year End CBA!!

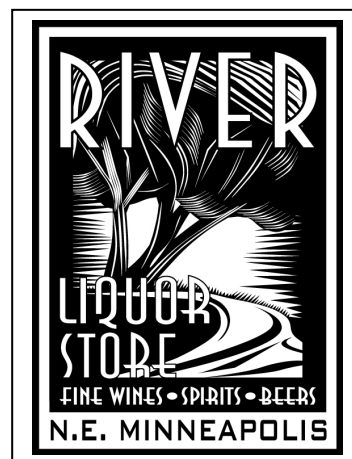

John Kreyer Wins 5th CBA Title at AMF Earle Brown Lanes

John Kreyer won his 5th CBA title at the March stop at AMF Earle Brown Lanes. Bowling against the hottest bowler this season, **Dan Bock**, Kreyer wasn't going to take any chances as he started the championship game strong, and with a late four-bagger took the title with a 234-180 win. Kreyer qualified 4th in Saturday's 10 game qualifying with a score of 2209 (220 avg) and proceeded to shoot 2714 (226 avg) while winning 8 ½ matches to take the top spot in the stepladder.

The first stepladder match had Bock up against January's champion **Luke Voaklander**. Bock, who will win his 2nd Bowler of the Year title, has 203 points through 11 tournaments and is within 22 points of the CBA record for points in a season held by **Carl Fietek**. Voaklander was no match for Bock as a split in the middle of the game had Bock winning 213-202. The next match had Bock up against Hall of Famer **Jeff Smith**, and was another easy win 204-169. The next match wasn't as easy as Bock had to face **Richard Vitko**, who was making his 3rd consecutive stepladder appearance. A couple of early opens by both players had Vitko ahead by 6 through 7 frames. Bock struck out from the 8th frame forcing Vitko to double in the 10th to win. A strike on the first ball and a solid 7-9 in the 11th cost Vitko as Bock came out ahead 216-209.

It took a score of 2079 (207 avg) to make the cut and qualify as 14 bowlers went on to match play. **Ron Lindner** won the bonus senior cash spot with 2030 and **Karyn Beckjorden** won the bonus woman cash spot with 1950. Saturday's qualifying leader was **David Langer** with a score of 2409 (240 avg) while shooting 300-802. **Ron Kish** won the rolloff for the "On Track Casher" by holding off all competitors in our 9th & 10th frame elimination rolloff.

We would like to thank manager **Lynn Roth**, who is transferring to AMF Maplewood Lanes, and lane man **Scott Sodergren** for hosting our tournament.
