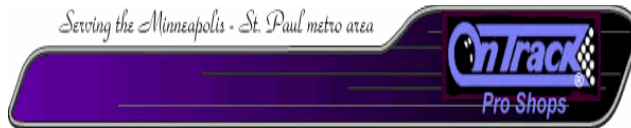

**Congratulations to CBA Hall of Famer Scott Pohl on winning the Gold Medal in the team event.**



*Team USA has focused on the team event since the Americans failed to medal in Doubles and Trios in the 2006 Men's World Championship at the Asiad Bowling Center in Busan, Korea. **Scott Pohl, Ronnie Sparks, David Haynes, Rhino Page, Bill Hoffman** (pictured with head coach **Jeri Edwards**), shot games of 1129, 1143 and 1123 to take the lead in the Team event after Squad 1 of 2 on long oil with 3395 pinfall total and average of 226.33. Two-time U.S. National Amateur Champion Hoffman led the team with 734, followed by Haynes with 702. Pohl added 692, Sparks 641 and Page 626. The United States, which won silver in team the past two World Championships, has not won the gold medal in the five-player team event in 35 years.*

## Carl Fietek Wins 14<sup>th</sup> CBA Title and takes Bowler of the Year lead at Flahertys Arden Bowl

**Carl Fietek** loaned out his Bowler of the Year title to **Dan Bock** last year and wants it back. With his win, Fietek now has 63 points after 3 tournaments and an 18 point lead over **Tom Korth**. Fietek and Korth squared off in the championship match at the August CBA at Flaherty's Arden Bowl and Fietek came away with his 14<sup>th</sup> CBA title. Korth started the match by converting the 3-9-10 split followed by 4 spares and a turkey. Fietek started with strike-2 spares and a four-bagger. Both bowlers opened late in the game and the match was within 12 pins going into the 10<sup>th</sup>. Fietek filled 20 pins to shut out Korth for a 215-203 victory.

The first stepladder match had last months and the CBA's most prolific champion, **Sam Lantto** up against Korth. Lantto needed to double in the 10<sup>th</sup> to win but left a solid 10 on the first shot as Korth won 210-181. **David Bordson** was up next and a double & four-bagger by Korth put Bordson away 225-182. Korth really wanted to get to the championship match as he started the semi final against **Clark Poelzer** with the front six and cruised to the victory 246-167.

Forty one bowlers started out the match play qualifying and it took a score of plus 115 (207 avg plus 55 bonus pins) to make the cut and **Chad Nelson** was the last cash at plus 113. The Qualifying Leader was Dale Seath with plus 191 (218 avg plus 40 bonus pins). **Sam Sylvester**, who didn't cash in the regular prize list, was the last cash in the Optional Qualifying Prize List. Twenty three bowlers bowled our 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame eliminator rolloff for the "**On Track Casher**" and **Dave Oulman** came away with the free entry into the September tournament.

There were 7 seniors (50 and over) who bowled the tournament as five made the cut (Korth, Poelzer, **Ron Lindner**, Seath and **Terry Schacht**) and two made the stepladder (Korth & Poelzer). I guess being over 50 doesn't make you forget how to bowl.

We would like to thank our hosts at Flahertys - **Dan Flaherty**, **Brian Hove** and **Dean Streich** – and their staff for hosting our August event.
