There has been a lot of talk lately about bowlers changing scoresheet or picking score sheets to bowl with their friends or teammates. The CBA does not allow this as there are bowlers who come to the tournaments by themselves and don't know very many bowlers. We want them to feel welcome and have a chance to bowl with some of the best bowlers in this area as they wouldn't normally have the chance. Anyone seen changing score sheets or picking one for their friends will be subject to a \$25.00 fine.

## Daron Hansen Goes Wire to Wire in Texas Hold 'Em Open for 8<sup>th</sup> CBA Title

**Daron Hansen** showed how to dominate a tournament by leading the Saturday 10 game qualifying with a score of 2432 (243 avg), shooting 2943 (245 avg) for the 12 match play games on Sunday, winning 9 matches to be the top seed for the stepladder, and then shooting 258 in the championship against **Brad Larson's** 224 for the victory and his 8<sup>th</sup> career CBA title.

While Hansen was waiting for his chance for the title, Larson was going through the stepladder to get his chance for victory. The first match for Larson was against the reigning bowler of the year **Dan Bock**. Both bowlers started with opens and a late turkey gave Larson the victory 203-190. **John Kreyer Jr** was up next, making the stepladder after bowling as the "*On Track Casher*", and a very close match had the bowlers within 9 pins in the 9<sup>th</sup> frame. Larson finished first with 247 and Kreyer Jr needed the first strike in the 10<sup>th</sup> to win but a solid 8 stopped him at 237. It didn't get any easier for Larson as **Chad Nelson**, who just took over the lead for bowler of the year by 1 point over Bock, was up next. Both bowlers started strong with early three baggers but a 7<sup>th</sup> frame open by Nelson had the match within 2 pins in the 9<sup>th</sup>. Larson needed the first strike in the 10<sup>th</sup> for the victory and calmly did to win 225-214. The championship match saw Hansen dominate by striking from the 2<sup>nd</sup> through the 7<sup>th</sup> frames and never giving Larson a chance.

It took a score of 2131 (213 avg) to make the cut and 2122 (212 avg) to cash. **Paul Mielens** was the Bonus Senior casher at 2088. **Ryan Schleicher**, bowling in his first CBA tournament, made the cut and his first game on Sunday was 297. Brad Larson shot his 4<sup>th</sup> - 1<sup>st</sup> game 300 on Sunday, he now has 11-300 games in CBA competition (**Carl Fietek** has the most with 12). Daron Hansen started Sunday's match play with scores of 260-277-279 for 816. **Jason Smith** won the 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame eliminator rolloff for the "*On Track Casher*" and a free entry into the December U S Open qualifying tournament.

The CBA would like to thank **Dave & Mike Bischoff** for their hospitality in hosting our CBA tournament and the annual Texas Hold 'Em card tournament. Chad Nelson was once the again the CBA bowler who went the furthest

On a sad note, **Leroy Meyer** passed away on Sunday morning during the match play.

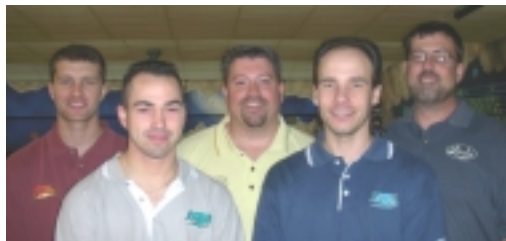
