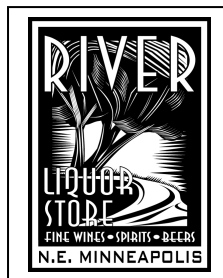

## Ron Lindner Captures First CBA Title at AMF Maple Lanes

**Ron Lindner** won the first tournament of the new CBA season and it was also his first title after bowling the CBA tournaments for over 30 years. He also became the oldest bowler to win a title, at 59 years, 10 months and 17 days he is 2 years older than **Bruce Forsland** who won when he was 57 years old. Lindner faced the tournament leader, **Don Luce** from Eau Claire, WI who was bowling in his first tournament in the title match. Luce started out with a double-spare-strike before opening with a split in the 5<sup>th</sup>. Lindner started strike-spare-spare and then showed his 30 year veteran stuff by striking on the next 4 shots to take a commanding lead in the 7<sup>th</sup>. Luce couldn't get his strike game going and veteran Lindner stayed clean to win 221-185.

The first stepladder match had **Bob Hager** facing new CBA vice-president **Jason Barnhouse**. An early four-bagger by Hager and with Barnhouse not able to get a strike, he had 7 – 9 spares, Hager won easily 237-196. Up next for Hager was last years' June champion and Rookie of the Year, **Seth Bonow**. Bonow struck on 8 of the first 9 shots and looked determined to repeat as champion as he won 246-215. The veteran Lindner wasn't going to let that happen as he took care of Bonow in the semi final match 233-151 to move on. Lindner and Bonow tied after 14 games of qualifying and match play for 2<sup>nd</sup> place going into the stepladder. Lindner won the 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame rolloff, 49-40, to be 2<sup>nd</sup> seeded.

Qualifying Leader was **Brent Stearns** with an 8 game score of 1893 (236 avg) and winning all 80 bonus pins. It took a score of 1854 including 50 bonus pins to cash and make the top 12 cut. **Chuck Barnhouse** won the bonus senior cash spot and **Ron Kish** held off all contestants in the 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame eliminator rolloff for the "*On Track Casher*" and a free entry into the July CBA tournament. **John McKinley** & **Ryan Burr** also made the cut bowling in their first ever tournaments.

We would like to thank **Linda Steeves** and the staff at AMF Maple Lanes for hosting our CBA tournament.

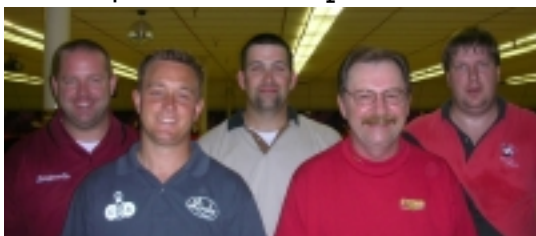
