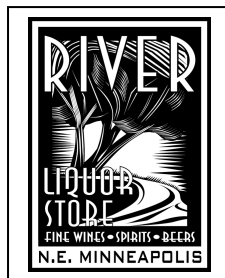

Clayton Mohr Wins 1st CBA Title at Garden Center Lanes

Alexandria's **Clayton Mohr** took advantage of making the cut, qualifying in the last spot on Saturday, and led the Sunday match play going into the stepladder. Mohr waited while Albert Lea's **Dan Bock** was going through the stepladder for the right to bowl for the championship. Mohr started the match with a double-open while Bock had strike-spare-strike through 4 frames. Mohr then decided to take charge and rattled off the next 5 strikes while Bock had a little trouble and went on to win 220-170 for his first CBA championship.

The first stepladder match had Bock up against St Cloud's **Jeff Walther**. Bock was too much as he started double-spare-four bagger while Walther was staying clean but not striking and Bock won 246-218. Bock was just warming up as the next match was against Little Falls' **Jeff Smith**. A seven-bagger in frames two through eight by Bock and an open between a couple strings by Smith had Bock winning 269-232. Bock moved on to face another Alexandrite and defending champion **Matt Meyer** in the semi final match. The shot seemed to be getting tougher as both bowlers struggled a little but Bock prevailed 210-194.

Saturday's Qualifying Leader was **Carl Fietek** at 2129 - plus 129 - for the 10 qualifying games, while it took a score of 2036 - plus 36 - to make the cut and **Dave Rasmus** took the last cash spot at 2022 - plus 22. The Bonus Senior cash spot went to Gene Captain at 1929 - minus 71 - because senior bowler and current point's leader **Ron Lindner** shot 265 in the last game on Saturday to make the cut for the 5th consecutive tournament. **Richard Vitko** made it through the 9th & 10th frame eliminator rolloff to win the "*On Track Casher*" and a free entry into the November CBA tournament.

The CBA would like to thank the entire **Meyer** family for hosting our CBA tournament and look forward to a bigger and better tournament next year as the hotel, which is connected to the bowling center, will be done in time for the tournament. The Saturday night party in the bar proved to be a great time as some people (person) had a little trouble getting to the center in time on Sunday.

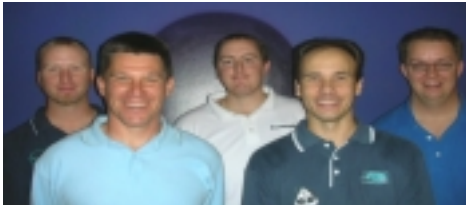
