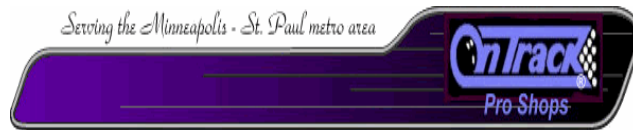

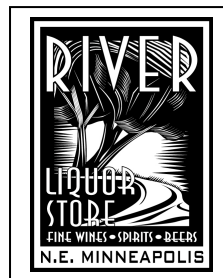

**Alternate Shot/Scotch Doubles Format**

**Saturday Qualifying** - There will be 16 games of Alternate Shot doubles with a break after 8 games for lunch. Bowlers decide who will start the 1<sup>st</sup> game and will alternate shots for the next 8 games. At the start of the 2<sup>nd</sup> block bowlers will again decide who will start and then alternate shots for the next 8 games. No bowler can throw back to back shots at any time. Who ever throws the final ball in the 10<sup>th</sup> frame cannot start the next game. (Except from game 8 to game 9).

**Sunday Match Play** – The top 8 or 12 teams will bowl 2 game matches followed by a stepladder. 35 entries or less top 8 make the cut and 36 or more top 12 make the cut. **The championship match will be video taped by the MNBowling Channel.** [www.mnbowling.com](http://www.mnbowling.com)

## Tom Korth Storms through Albert Lea for 2<sup>nd</sup> CBA Title

With the weather “*Storming*” outside **Tom Korth** took his “*Storm*” bowling balls inside and “*Stormed*” through the field at the February stop of the CBA at Holiday Lanes for his 2<sup>nd</sup> CBA title. Korth started out the Saturday qualifying with 269-287-245 for 801 and continued “*Storming*” through Sunday match play by averaging 241 for the 12 games to take the top seed heading into the stepladder finals. Korth, from Mankato, took on Owatonna’s **Chad Nelson** in the championship match and “*Stormed*” out of the gate with the first 4 strikes before leaving the 4-7 and chopping it in the 5<sup>th</sup>. After a couple of 10 pin spares for Nelson in frames 2 and 4 surrounded by strikes Korth held a 6 pin lead in the 5<sup>th</sup> frame. Korth came “*Storming*” back by striking in frames 6 through 8 and another 10 pin by Nelson after a turkey had the lead up to 18 pins in the 8<sup>th</sup>. Korth just needed to stay clean in the 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> and he did so by picking up a couple single pins to capture his 2<sup>nd</sup> CBA title almost 8 years to the day from his first.

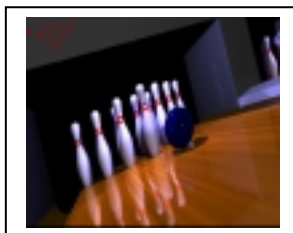
The first stepladder match had **Clark Poelzer**, last month’s champion, taking on the reigning Bowler of the Year, from “Storm Nation” **Dan Bock**. A six-bagger in the middle of the game by Poelzer with Bock having some carry trouble, had Poelzer winning the match 248-215. The next match had Poelzer wondering what happened as he took on **Mark Luttczens**. Luttczens started striking and never stopped as he became just the 4<sup>th</sup> bowler to shoot a 300 in the stepladder finals. **Jerry Holldorf** had the first back in November of 1993 at Wagners in Eau Claire and won \$5000 for it. **Tim Mayer** had one in March of 1994 at Country Lanes in Duluth and **Bob Klatt** had his at Lynbrook Bowl in the Linds Tournament of Champions in May 1997 and won \$500 donated by **Chris Harrison Tile Co**. Luttczens moved on to face Nelson in the semi final match and a close match had Nelson winning 206-194.

50 Bowlers started out the Saturday qualifying and the top 16 cash & cut was plus 218 for the 10 games and **Dave Oulman** was the qualifying leader with plus 362. **Ron Lindner** won the bonus senior cash spot with a score of plus 174. **Chad Nelson** also had a 300 on Sunday with a 3 game stretch of 279-225-300 for 804. The “On Track Casher” 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame eliminator rolloff was won by **Rob Aimers** and he will get a free entry into the April CBA tournament.

A huge Thank You to **Loren Kaiser** and **Dustin Barr** for their hospitality and we are looking forward to continuing the success of the tournament at Holiday Lanes next year.
