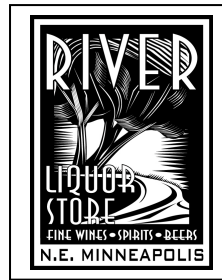

Langer Brothers Win Another Doubles Title

David and Dan Langer have now won 3 of the last 4 CBA doubles tournaments as they came out victorious at the 2nd Annual Alternate Shot Doubles tournament held at **Memory Lanes** on March 15th & 16th, 2008. Bowling against the duo of **Matt McNiel & Scott Pohl** in the 2 game total pins match, the Langers faced a 46 pin deficit after the 1st game as McNiel/Pohl shot 279. The 2nd game was a lesson in addition. The Langers started out the match with the front 5 before David left the bucket and Dan spared while McNiel/Pohl had 3-bagger-spare-double and then a split by Pohl that McNiel couldn't convert for 155 through the 7th frame. The Langers started striking again while McNiel/Pohl went strike-spare-strike-spare for 215 and a 2 game total of 494. Dan struck the first ball in the 10th for a 4-bagger and David left a 7 count split in the 11th, Pohl thought the best they could get was 260 for that game so he thought they won but Dan got the 2 pins for 262 and a 2 game total of 495. This was the 3rd CBA title for Dan and the 9th for David.

The first stepladder match had the Point leaders, **Dan Bock & Chad Nelson** up against the senior duo of **John Eiss** and **Dave Hoppenrath**. Bock/Nelson struck in 8 of the first 9 frames for a 33 pin lead after the first game and held on for a match win of 473-447. Bock/Nelson then had to take on McNiel/Pohl and a couple opens by Bock/Nelson in the first game had them facing a 49 pin deficit that they couldn't overcome as McNiel/Pohl went on to a 478-440 win. Up next was the tough team of **Jason Barnhouse** and **Carl Fietek**. After the first game, 8 pins separated the 2 teams with McNeil/Pohl shooting 224 to Barnhouse/Fietek's 216. A back and forth 2nd game had the match very close going into the 10th. Barnhouse/Fietek struck out from the 8th to force McNiel to get the 2nd strike in the 10th to win. He calmly did to win the match 464-462.

A total of 41 teams started the 16 games of qualifying on Saturday and it took a score of 3413 (213 avg) to make the top 12 cut while the Qualifying Leaders were **Bob Hager** and **Mark Lutchens** with 3645 (27 avg). **Tom Jones & Tim Hoke** took the last cash spot with 3398 (212 avg) and the bonus senior cash spot went to **Tom Korth & Ron Lindner**.
