## **Baker Doubles Format**

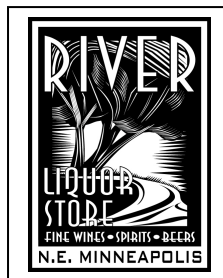

## Dan Bock Goes Wire-to-Wire at Garden Center Lanes for 8<sup>th</sup> CBA Title

**Dan Bock** showed why he has won 3 consecutive Bowler of the Year titles. Qualifying first after the 10 games of qualifying on Saturday with a score of 2213 (221 avg), Bock proceeded to win 9 of his 10 matches on Sunday to be the leader going into the stepladder finals. In the championship match against **Sam Sylvester Jr**, Bock was leaving nothing in doubt as he started with spare-turkey-spare and then went off the sheet to win his 8<sup>th</sup> title 268-198. Sylvester was trying to be the 2<sup>nd</sup> bowler to win a CBA title as the *“On Track Casher”*. **Ron Kish** holds this distinction.

The first stepladder match had Alexandria’s **Matt Meyer** against Super Senior **Ron Lindner**. A couple of late opens by Lindner had Meyer needing to mark in the 10<sup>th</sup> win, which he did for a 189-169 victory. Up next for Meyer was current Bowler of the Year leader **Chad Nelson**. A close match through the first 5 frames had Nelson in front by a pin and then Nelson decided to take control and didn’t miss the rest of the way for a 250-191 victory. Nelson had a little trouble in the next match while Sylvester took charge with a late double to win 196-158 and set the stage for the championship match.

It took a score of 2004 (200 avg) to make the cut while **Ron Kish** took the last cash at 2001 for the 10 games. There was no bonus senior casher as **Ron Lindner** made the cut but **Lisa Noor** won the bonus woman casher with a score of 1948. Four women, Lisa, **Kim Wirth**, **Tracey Magnuson** and **Mindie Meyer** bowled and **Deb Hoffman** made the trip to celebrate Lisa’s 3 years of cancer free. Congratulations Lisa – I know you had a good time. **Dave Bordson** came out of the bar in tennis shoes to bowl in the *“On Track Casher”* 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame eliminator rolloff and proceeded to win for a free entry into the November CBA tournament.

The CBA would like to thank the entire Meyer family and their staff for hosting yet another CBA tournament.
