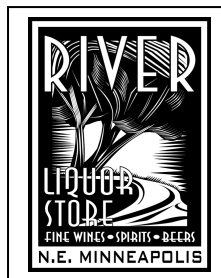

Jeff Smith Wins 15th CBA Title at Matties Lanes

Jeff Smith of Little Falls led all 51 qualifiers on Saturday with a near record performance of 2541 pins (254 avg) for the 10 games and carried that over to Sunday's Match Play. **Sam Sylvester Jr** of Hugo was Sunday's top seed going into the stepladder as he shot games of 268-259-279 for 806 in his last 3 match play games to overtake Smith. It only seemed fitting that the top 2 bowlers of the weekend were facing each other for the title. A 5th frame split by Sylvester Jr had Smith ahead by 30 pins but he finished with the last 6 to force Smith to mark in the 10th to win. Smith left a 7-pin and easily spared it to win 248-228 and his 15th CBA title to put him in sole possession of 2nd place in CBA titles behind **Sam Lantto's** 20.

The first stepladder match had the Bowler of the Year leader, Owatonna's **Chad Nelson**, up against Otsego's **Richard Vitko**, who recently moved back from Colorado. Two turkeys by Nelson and an early open split by Vitko had Nelson winning easily 236-192. Up next for Nelson was Farmington's **Robert Slayton** who was making his first ever singles stepladder. He looked like an established veteran as he seemed to strike at will shooting 264 to Nelson's 195. The semifinal match came down to the 10th frame as Smith needed the 1st strike in the 10th to shut out Slayton but was stopped by a 7-pin. With the door open Slayton needed a double to win but was stopped in the 11th by a 10-pin so Smith moved on 224-218.

Jeff Smith was only 10-pins behind the qualifying record of 2551 pins set by **Lee Stritesky** at Apple Place Bowl in 2003. It took a score of 2079 (207.9 avg) to make the top 16 cut and 2062 (206.2 avg) to cash. **Clark Poelzer** at 2053 and **Dale Seath** at 1995 were the bonus senior cashers. Menomonie's **Mike Holzhueter** held off everybody in the "*On Track Casher*" 9th & 10th frame eliminator rolloff to win the free entry for the December CBA tournament. Jeff Smith with a 299 and **Dan Bock** with a 296 were the only other honor scores of the weekend.

Matt Ross proved once again that he is one of the hardest working proprietors in the business. Thanks to Matt and his staff for hosting another successful CBA tournament.

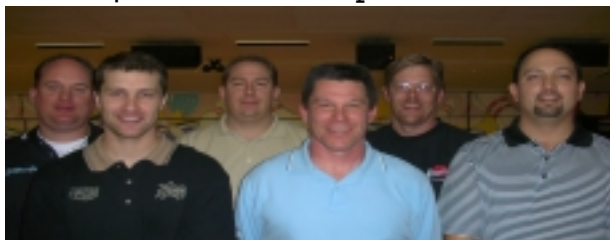
