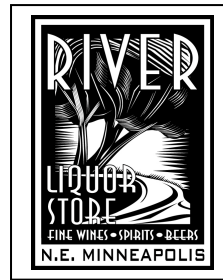

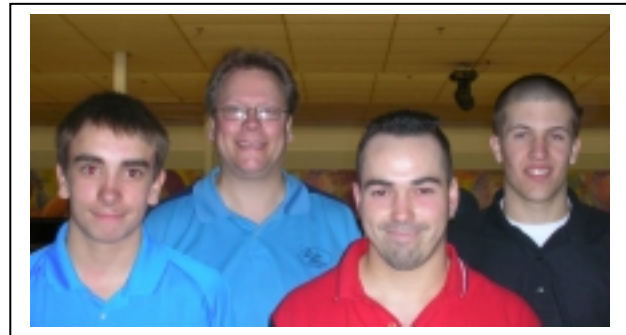
We have now added another sponsor to the year end tournament. Aaron & Dan Barnhouse and their company Barnhouse Exteriors will sponsor a new shootout.

We're not sure of the exact format yet but Barnhouse Exteriors will pay \$300 for 1<sup>st</sup> - \$200 for 2<sup>nd</sup> & \$100 for 3<sup>rd</sup>.

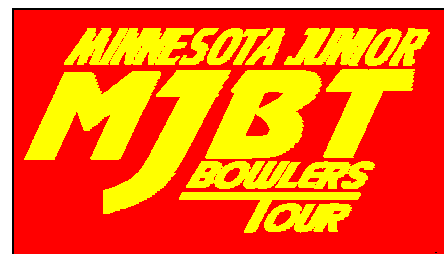

## Carl Fietek Shows His Stuff on Way to 15<sup>th</sup> Career Title

CBA Hall of Famer and 7-time Bower of the Year, **Carl Fietek**, showed that he is still a bowler to be reckoned with as he came out on top at the January CBA at Granite Bowl South in St Cloud. Qualifying in 9<sup>th</sup> position after the 8 qualifying games, Fietek slowly made his way towards the top during the match play to be the leader heading into position round in our carry over pins no stepladder format. Fietek had a 9 pin lead over **John Kreyer Jr** and not only did he have to win the match but had to have a high enough score to hold off the 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> place challengers **Bob Hager & Ryan Schleicher**. Fietek and Kreyer Jr were dueling it out while Hager and Schleicher were throwing lots of strikes on the pair next to them. Fietek needed the first strike in the 10<sup>th</sup> to beat Kreyer Jr 257 to 246 and win his 15<sup>th</sup> CBA title. Hager shot 269 to Schleicher's 248 to move into 2<sup>nd</sup> while Kreyer Jr was 3<sup>rd</sup> and Schleicher 4<sup>th</sup>. Super Senior **Ron Lindner** held onto 5<sup>th</sup> by shooting 239 in the position round while **Jason Barnhouse** had a 248 and stayed 6<sup>th</sup>.

Fifty bowlers started the day and **Dale Seath** was the Qualifying Leader with a score of 1958 (244 avg) for the 8 games of qualifying while it took 1794 (224 avg) to make the top 16 cut and cash. **Tim Hoke** won the Bonus Senior casher with 1749 (218 avg). Last Years Rookie of the Year, **Ryan Burr** held off all challengers in the 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame eliminator rolloff to win the "On Track Casher" and a free entry into the February CBA tournament at Holiday Lanes in Albert Lea.

**Rod Neuenschwander, John Kreyer Jr** and **Dan Bock** all shot 300's during qualifying for the only honor scores of the tournament.

With 4 tournaments to go **Chad Nelson** is holding a 42 point lead over **Dan Bock** in the Bowler of the Year race. Bock is the 3-time defending bowler of the year champion. **Carl Fietek** moved into 3<sup>rd</sup> after the win while **Sam Sylvester Jr** is 4<sup>th</sup> and **Jeff Smith** is 5<sup>th</sup>. **Matt Wratz** is our Rookie of the Year leader.

We would like to thank our host proprietors **Mike & Dave Bischoff**, General Manager **Jeff Cypher** and Bowling Manager **Ben Goede** for hosting our tournament and again making it very successful.
