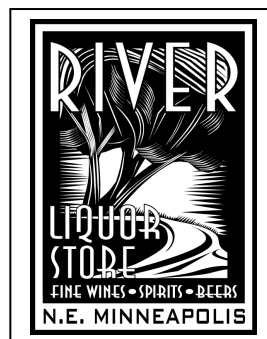

Nick Larson is “Super” at Super Bowl for First CBA Title

Nick Larson, making his first stepladder appearance, was absolutely “super” when he got to the championship match. Bowling against **Tony Reis**, who made the stepladder for the 2nd time and was the #1 seed, Larson wasn’t going to let his chance slip by. Starting out with a strike-spare-spare-strike, Larson had a 33 pin lead in the 4th after Reis had back-to-back splits in the 3rd & 4th frames. Six more consecutive “super” strikes later Larson had a 259 while Reis could only muster a 181.

The first stepladder match had **Carl Fietek** up against **Pat Umphrey** and the 17 time CBA titleist and Hall of Famer had no trouble by shooting 268 to Umphrey’s 190. Fietek struggled in the next match by only managing a 175 to Larson’s 200. Carl was hoping to get by that game so he could make CBA history by bowling against his son **Brandon Fietek**. Brandon, bowling in his first CBA tournament, qualified 11th and was seeded 2nd in the stepladder. Brandon ran into some split trouble and Larson had a late turkey to win 191-142.

Dan Beckjorden was the qualifying leader with a score of 1854 (231 avg) for the 8 games of qualifying while it took a score of 1739 (217.3 avg) to make the cut and 1736 (217.0 avg) to cash. **Dale Seath** won the bonus senior casher and **Tracey Magnuson**, as the only woman bowler, took home the bonus woman casher.

Matt Smallin from Fargo held off everyone in the 9th & 10th frame eliminator rolloff to win the “*On Track Casher*” and a free entry into the August CBA at Texa Tonka Lanes.

We would like to thank our host proprietors **Mike & Matt Anderson** along with General Manager **David Langer** and Lane Man **Mike Cowan** for hosting our CBA tournament.

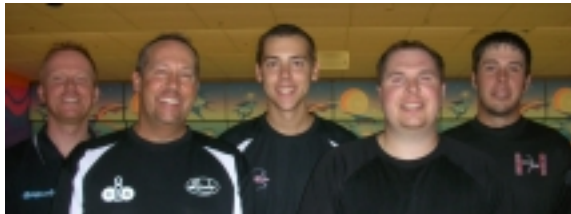
