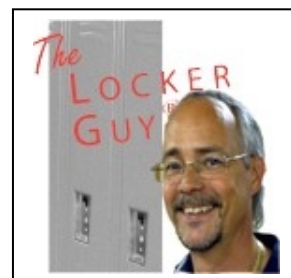
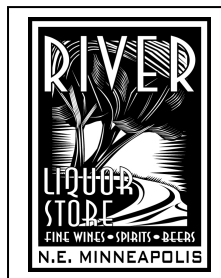

January's CBA at Huikko's will have A&B Squads. Members who sign up 10 days prior to tournament will have choice of squads after that I will assign as I will try to have the same number of bowlers on each squad.



The Barnhouse Exteriors "full sody" shootout (named after Scott Sodergren as I believe he is the only person to ever have the front 11 and get only the 1-2-5-8 for a 294) is held after qualifying of the Year End CBA tournament. The top 12 finalists will throw at the 3-4-6-7-9-10. Low count is out each frame and whoever knocks down the most pins wins - all pins knocked down are accumulative. 1st place is \$300, 2nd \$200 and 3rd \$100. Our defending champion is David Langer.

12 bowlers from the non finalists plus last years' defending champion, Dale Seath will participate. Each bowler throws 1 one ball and low count is out each frame. 1st place is \$400, 2nd \$300, 3rd \$200 and 4th \$100. \$500 is donated from the above 2 sponsors and \$500 comes from the bracket proceeds.

Mikes Pro Shop CBA Points Challenge

The Linds Invitational in September was the first leg of the Mikes Pro Shop CBA Points Challenge. The other 3 tournaments are the November tournament at Brunswick Zone, Lakeville, the US Open in December and the Year End in April. The bowler with the most points garnered for these 4 tournaments will win the \$300.00 prize from Mikes Pro Shop. Matt McNiell Wins Chameleon Challenge at Brunswick Zone, Lakeville for 3rd CBA Title of Season

Chanhasen's **Matt McNiell** has been pretty hot lately (kind of an understatement) as he won the Chameleon Challenge for his 3rd CBA title overall, 3rd this season, 2nd consecutive and he has only entered 3 tournaments this season. With a classic battle in the championship match against CBA Hall of Famer, **David Langer**, McNiell was ahead by 1 pin in the 7th frame as both bowlers had a turkey and 3 – 9 spares. McNiell set himself up by striking in the 8th & 9th frames while Langer spared the 8th and then struck out from the 9th to force McNiell to double to win. As hot as McNiell was you knew he would be up the challenge and he did to win 246-238.

The first stepladder match had last years' US open champion **David Oulman** up against one of the best bowlers yet to win a CBA title, **Dave Bordson**. With the match pretty even after 6 frames Oulman ran off a five-bagger while Bordson was going spare-strike-spare-strike-spare in the last 5 frames to win 243-200. Up next for Oulman was 10 time titleist Langer and after a 7-9 split in the 2nd Langer strung together 7 strikes to win 247-225. Langer was facing another 1-time CBA title holder in the next match, **Rob Clements**. With 3 turkeys throughout the game, Langer took care of Clements who could only manage 2 doubles and a bunch of 9 spares, 244-216.

Little Falls' **Jeff Smith** was the Saturday Qualifying Leader with a score of 2297 (229.7 avg) for the 10 games on the Chameleon Pattern. It took a score of 2101 (210.1 avg) by **Eric Schacht**, making the cut for the first time, to make the cut and 2100 (210.0 avg) to tie for last cash by a couple Hall of Famers, **Chad Nelson & Rob Downer**. **Ed Mahagnoul** with a score of 2098 (209.8 avg) won the bonus senior cash spot and 1st time bowler **Erin Novak** won the bonus woman casher. The 9th & 10th frame Eliminator Rolloff for the "**On Track Casher**" was won by none other than On Track's own **Gary Arntzen**. **Nick Korpi** won the High Game out of the money prize which was donated by CBA Founder and Hall of Famer **John Dorek**.

The CBA would like to give our appreciation to Brunswick Zone's manager **Eric Schmidt** for hosting our CBA tournament and donating \$234 to our prize list as we look forward to going back to this fine establishment next year.
