The men will bowl 6 more games and the women will bowl 4 more games and both will be followed by a stepladder. If we get less than 16 women we will take the top 4 but still cash 1 for 2.

We will count these first 2 tournaments towards the Year End for the Women provided they pay the \$50.00 membership and pay the \$6.00 per entry for the Year End fund. This should help for the Women bowlers who would like to get their 4 tournaments in to qualify for the CBA Year End Added Money Tournament.

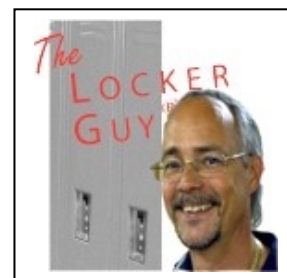
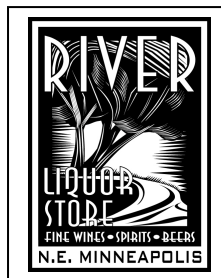

Useless Stuff

Luke Voaklander was just average at the May CBA. His first game of the day was 209 and his 8th game was 209. For the 8 games of qualifying he shot 1674 – 209 average. For the 8 games of match play he shot 1674 – 209 average. The 14 bowlers who bowled match play knocked down 23,456 pins – a 209 average. The 4 bowlers who bowled the stepladder knocked down 1674 pins for the 8 games for a 209 average. **Jeff Smith, Dave Bordson & Tom Korth** were the only other bowlers to have a 209 game.

Brandon Fietek on 1 shot was all even as he knocked down only the 1-3-5-7-9 pins and left all the even ones. He didn't pick up the spare though. This was the 2nd time this has happened in the CBA as **Richard Vitko** did this at Minnehaha.

Scott Sodergren, who took out only the 1-2-5-8 pins for a 294 game at Minnehaha way back in the 90's is the reason for the "full sody" Barnhouse Exteriors Shootout. This was the one & only time he did this until May at the State tournament in Willmar where he did it twice. It didn't bother him much as he went on to shoot 800 in doubles to win that event along with the scratch All Events and the Team Event. He had a total of 7 titles in the 2010 State Tournament.

Dan Bock Wins 11th CBA Title at the First Ever CBA/LCBA EXXXtravaganza at Flaherty's

Dan Bock, defending his 2009-2010 Bowler of the Year Title, started the season off right by winning the first tournament of the 2010-2011 season. We had the Men & Women bowling together but qualifying separately for the first time and the tournament was a huge success. Bock, who qualified 7th with a score of 1717 (214 avg) for the 8 games but took the top spot for the stepladder after the 8 games of match play in which he shot 1932 (241 avg) including a 300 game, took on qualifying leader **Sam Sylvester Jr** who shot 1859 (232 avg) to lead all 47 Men Bowlers. Both bowlers struggled in the match but a late open by Sylvester Jr and a double by Bock gave him the victory with a score of 199-178.

The first stepladder match had a couple seniors in **John Eiss & Tom Korth** facing off. Eiss showed the youngster that he still knows how to bowl as he put away Korth 234-178. Up next for Eiss was another senior and the Bowler of the Decades, **Clark Poelzer**. A classic battle ensued as both bowlers showed their experience at keeping the ball in play and picking up spares. Except for an 8-10 split by Poelzer all frames were filled and Eiss forced Poelzer to mark the 10th and he did with a strike to move on 234-217. Poelzer had a clean game but left too many 10-pins and Sylvester Jr had 2 opens but a double and a five-bagger of which the last 2 were the first 2 in the 10th to beat Poelzer 218-216.

After Sylvester Jr's leading qualifying score of 1859, it took a score of 1659 (207.3 avg) by **John Hommes** to make the top 14 cut and 1656 (207 avg) by **Nick Hogan**, who was bowling in his first CBA tournament to cash. **Brandon Fietek** who is bowling as a junior and can only compete for scholarship dollars, qualified 9th and then in the 5th game of match play shot his first ever sanctioned 300 game.

The bonus senior cash spots went to **Terry Schacht** 1620 (202 avg) and **Dale Seath** 1595 (199 avg) and **Steve Goetsch** won the 9th & 10th frame eliminator rolloff to win the "On Track Casher" and a free entry into the June CBA tournament.

We would like to thank proprietors **Dan & Tom Flaherty** and bowling manager **Brian Hove** and their staff for hosting our CBA tournament.

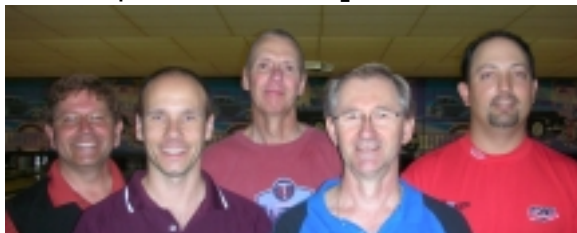

Lisa Noor Wins 1st Ever CBA/LCBA EXXXtravaganza at Flaherty's

Lisa Noor won all 240 bonus points available when she shot 927 (231 avg) in the 4 game match play after she qualified 2nd in the 8 game qualifying as we mixed the Men & Women bowlers together for the first time. In the championship match against **Tracey Magnuson**, Noor had a late four-bagger and forced Magnuson to double in the 10th to win. A 10 pin stopped Tracey and Lisa took the title with a 205-201 victory. The first stepladder match had sisters **Deb Lantto** and **Lisa Johnson** squaring off. A five-bagger in the middle of the game by Lisa propelled her to a 243-204 win. Lisa had to face Tracey in the semi final match and it came down to the 10th frame as Lisa forced Tracey to mark and she did with a spare to win by a score of 204-192.

Tracey led all 21 Women bowlers in the 8 game qualifying with 1664 (208 avg) while it took a score of 1559 (194 avg) to make the top 8 cut and 1512 (189 avg) to cash.
