CBA Logo patches will be available at all tournaments. All members & non-members must have a CBA logo displayed on their shirt or they must purchase a patch for \$7.00. All bowlers must have their names and CBA logos on their shirts for both days and no bowlers are allowed to wear jeans on Sundays. A \$10.00 fine will be issued for bowlers late for paddock on Sunday. Paddock is always at 7:40 AM.

### **CBA Highlights for 2004-2005**

#### ***Tournament Formats:***

The July tournament will consist of 6 games of qualifying and then cut to the top 24 regardless of entries. The top 24 will bowl 3 more games and then cut to the top 12 who will also bowl 3 more games. All pins will carry over. The cash ratio will still be 1 for 3. The top 6 will bowl a stepladder. 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> will bowl a one game match and then the winner will advance to bowl against the 3<sup>rd</sup> place, etc.

The August tournament will consist of 8 match play games from the start with a 10 pin bonus per match. We will cut to the top 8 and they will bowl standard match for 7 games with the 30 bonus pins and all carry over and then the position round will decide the champion. This format will not include a stepladder.

#### ***Optionals***

Brackets for the 6 game qualifying will be games 1-2-3 and 4-5-6. The 8 game qualifying will be games 2-3-4, 3-4-5 and 5-6-7.

Bet You'll Win will be the same but we are thinking about adding a \$20 pot also.

Mini Eliminator will still have 2 sessions for each format.

Bonus women and senior cashes will stay the same.

Year End will still need 4 to qualify but it will change to the standard 1 for 3 cash instead of 1 for 2 and the cut will **NOT** be a guaranteed 24.

## John Kreyer Jr Wins at AMF Maple Lanes for 1<sup>st</sup> CBA Title

**John Kreyer Jr** has been moving up the ladder becoming one of the better bowlers in the area. He was 2<sup>nd</sup> at the U S Open qualifying last December and again 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Year End tournament in May losing to **Scott Pohl**. The 3<sup>rd</sup> time was a charm for Kreyer as he wasn't going to be denied for his first CBA title. Kreyer started out the championship match with strike-spare-4-bagger to easily put away Pohl in the rematch of the Year End tournament 239-177. Kreyer shot 1917 (239 avg) for the 8 games of qualifying putting him 7<sup>th</sup>. He vaulted into 1<sup>st</sup> after 2 games and held the top spot for the rest of the way.

The first stepladder match had Pohl up against last years' Rookie of the Year, **David Oulman**. Both bowlers matched strings in the middle of the game and Pohl left an opening for Oulman as he went strike-9spare in the 10<sup>th</sup>. Oulman, needing a double to win could only manage 9-spare-9 and Pohl won 256-247. Pohl was then up against **Luke Voaklander** who has made the cut for the 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive tournament. Pohl easily dispatched Voaklander 255-213. Up next was fellow CBA Hall of Fame member, Bowler of the Year multiple winner and Teammate, **Carl Fietek**. A great battle ensued and Pohl had to strike on the count ball to win 237-236 to set up the championship match.

**Richard Vitko** was the Qualifying Leader with a score of 1996 (249.5 avg) for the 8 games. **Travis Hersrud** shot a 300 in the first game for the High Game out of Money. Other honor scores were 300-846 for **Tom Jones** & 825 for **John Hommes**. **Ron Kish** won the rolloff for the "*On Track Cashier*" and a free entry into the July Tournament.
