Directions to Great River Bowl from I94: take hwy 15 exit in St Cloud and head north. Drive through St Cloud and turn left onto County Road 1 into Sartell. Stay on County Road 1 for about 1.5 miles to a stop light by the Holiday station. Turn left at that light and head up the hill to an all way stop sign and turn left. If you turn right you will go over a bridge – **Don't Do This!** Great River Bowl is a block and ½ on the left side.

Direction from Hwy 10: Take County Road 29 – Sartell exit – Head west on County Road 29, cross over hwy 15 for about 5 miles until you come to an all way stop sign. Go through that intersection and cross the bridge – **OK To Do This!!** – Great River Bowl will be approx ½ mile on the left.

We ask that you please let me know if you cannot make it. If you do plan on bowling, please let me know, as it is easier for me to plan.* Paddock is always 1/2 hour before scheduled starting time.

#### **One Squad - Paddock: 12:00 Noon - Bowling: 12:30 PM**

*Format: 10 games of qualifying with the top 12, 16 or 20 making the cut to Sunday Match Play. Bowl 12 games of match play starting at 8:00 AM on Sunday followed by a 5 bowler stepladder.*

They must be within the last 2 years.

There will be **NO** reduced entries for the Baker Doubles, Eau Claire, the U S Open or the Year End. Everyone will pay the full \$110 entry but if you would have qualified for a reduced entry we will be glad to give it to you at a later tournament.

## John Kreyer Jr. Stays “Red Hot” as he Wins 2<sup>nd</sup> CBA Tournament

**John Kreyer Jr** was “Red Hot” over the summer months as he dominated at the CBA at River City Lanes for his 2<sup>nd</sup> CBA title. In the CBA’s newest format, 8 games of match play qualifying with 10 bonus pins per match followed by 8 standard match play games and no stepladder, Kreyer Jr was the qualifying leader with a score of 1864 (233 avg) plus 60 bonus pins. Kreyer Jr started the match play with a 300 game, his 2<sup>nd</sup> of the day as he had one in the 4<sup>th</sup> game of qualifying, and was leading going into the position round. Facing the hard charging **Chad Nelson**, who was within 19 pins of the lead, he started the position round and final game of the tournament with the front 10 before a 6 pin stopped him from tying **Roger Blad** with 3-300’s in the same tournament. He finished with a 289 and Nelson garnered yet another 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish, we think his 14<sup>th</sup> but we have to check all the records.

**Dustin Barr**, **Carl Fietek** and **Sam Lantto** rounded out the top 5 with a revitalized **Terry Schacht** taking 6<sup>th</sup> place and moving into a tie for 4<sup>th</sup> in the Bowler of the Year race. After 3 tournaments Kreyer Jr has 73 points, only 8 points from the maximum if he had been the qualifying leader and won all 3. He won the June tournament and was 3<sup>rd</sup> in July. Add to that a 2<sup>nd</sup> at least years’ Year-End and you can see why the “Red Hot” label is his.

With seniors **Terry Schacht**, **Ron Lindner** and **Ed Mahagnoul** cashing, **Tom Korth** won the bonus senior cash spot, probably for a record 8<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup> time. **Dave Schick** won the rolloff for the “*On Track Casher*” and a free entry into the September Linds Invitational tournament. Proprietor **Mark Parnell** won the High Game out of money with a 267, tying a record for the least amount of shots thrown in one game.

It took a score of 1802 with bonus pins to make the cut to standard match play and 1744 to cash.

A big Thank You to Mark Parnell and his staff for hosting our tournament.
