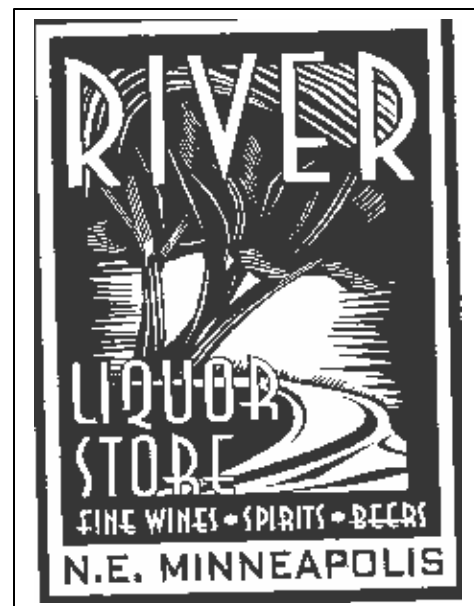

## Chad Nelson Wins Linds Invitational For 5<sup>th</sup> CBA Title

**Chad Nelson** of Owatonna always seems to be near the top of the “Major” tournaments and the “*Linds Invitational*” was no exception. Nelson won the Mikes Pro Shop CBA Points Challenge last year, which gives \$300 to the bowler with the most points in the “Bloody Mary Open”, the US Open and the Year-End. This year we added the “Linds Invitational to the other 3 tournaments and Nelson starts out in the lead. While shooting an 825 series in games 7-8-9 of qualifying after a 156 start, Nelson totaled 2301 (230 avg) to qualify in the 7<sup>th</sup> position. During Sunday match play Nelson averaged 240 for 8 games but it was only enough for 4<sup>th</sup> position in the stepladder as **Pat Umphrey** shot 2101 (262 avg) while winning 7 of 8 matches to be plus 711, which is believed to be a CBA record for 8 match play games and the top spot. **Brad Larson** and **Carl Fietek** averaged 249 for their 8 match play games but Larson won 5 matches and Fietek only 4 to be seeded 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> respectively.

The stepladder matches started with Nelson & Fietek matching four baggers early in the match and Fietek doubling and nine in the 10<sup>th</sup> frame to force Nelson to strike-9 spare to win, which he did for a 248-247 victory. Nelson had an easy time with Larson starting with a four-bagger to Larson’s open-spare-strike-spare and won easily 276-209. In the championship match both bowlers started with doubles but then Umphrey had high pocket splits in the 3<sup>rd</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> frames for opens while Nelson strung a four-bagger to win 225-183 for his 5<sup>th</sup> CBA title and first “*Linds Invitational*” championship.

**Dave Schick** won the rolloff for the “*On Track Casher*” and a free entry into the Garden Center tournament, for the 2<sup>nd</sup> tournament in a row. “New” senior **Lee Stritesky** won the bonus senior cash spot. Other honor scores were 300’s by Larson, Fietek and Umphrey and an 835 by Umphrey. **Dustin Barr** picked up the 7-10 and Larson showed his Hall of Fame stuff in the last game of qualifying on Saturday. Larson was neck & neck with **John Kreyer Jr** for the 8<sup>th</sup> and final cut spot. Larson left the 2-8-10 split and after watching Kreyer pick up the 7-pin, needed to spare and get 7 pins to take the 8<sup>th</sup> spot. A certain tournament director could have made a lot of money if he could have found someone to bet with him that Larson would simply throw a back up and pick up the spare.

The CBA would like to thank **Lyle Mathiasen, Bob Beltz** and **Rod Neuenschwander** for hosting the CBA for the first time and of course Thanks to **Jeff Lind & David Wiggins** of *The Lind Shoe Company* for all they do for us.
