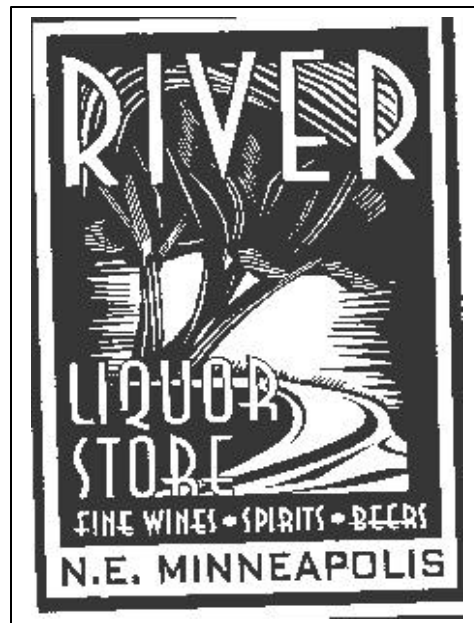

Dominating Chad Nelson Wins At Eau Claire for 7th CBA Title

Chad Nelson has been on quite a Dominating roll in the past few CBA events. The first tournament of the 2004-2005 season that Chad bowled in was August at River City Lanes and he finished 2nd. He then won the Linds Invitational at Great River bowl in Sartell and did not cash in Alex (which is unusual because he won in 2003 and was 2nd in 2002). He then teamed up with **Dan Bock** to win the Baker Doubles at Minnehaha and then became the 17th bowler to win back-to-back titles as he won the “Bloody Mary Open” at Wagners in Eau Claire. He also did well in 2003 in Eau Claire as he finished 2nd.

Nelson started out the championship match against **Carl Fietek** with the first 5 strikes while Fietek had a couple 6 count spares and found himself 40 pins behind by the 4th frame. Fietek managed a four bagger in the middle of the game but the Dominating Nelson only missed once and bagged his 7th CBA title 279-232.

The stepladder matches had Hall of Famers and soon to be Hall of Fame rs. **Jeff Smith** (who will be inducted next year) bowled against **Rob Downer** (who only needs 4.6 more Hall of Fame points to qualify) in the 1st stepladder match. Downer took care of Smith easily 239-179. Downer then had to face 2003 Hall of Fame inductee **Scott Pohl**. A clean game and a double for Pohl gave him 206 while Downer had a turkey and 2 opens and needed to double in the 10th to shoot 209. Downer then had to face the Dominating Nelson (who now has the required 200 Hall of Fame points but will have to wait for Smith and **David Langer** to be inducted). Nelson dominated the game and moved on by shooting a 254 to Downer’s 160 and faced 1999 Hall of Fame inductee Fietek in the championship match.

The Qualifying Leader was **David Langer** (who shot the only 300 of the tournament, Fietek had a 300 in the sweeper) with a score of 2253 (225 avg). It took a score of 204.5 to make the cut and 200.9 to cash. **Terri Anderson** won the Bonus Woman casher and **Rich Peterson** of Eau Claire took the Bonus Senior Casher. **Keith Howard** won the rolloff for the “On Track Casher” and a free entry into the December CBA.

Thanks again to Proprietor **Steve Hanson** and his staff for hosting another successful CBA tournament.
