One Squad - Paddock: 8:30 AM - Bowling: 9:00 AM

Format: 8 games of qualifying match play with 10 bonus pins per match with the top 8, 12 or 16 (depending on entries) making the cut. They will then bowl standard match play with 30 bonus pins per match. If 8 qualify we will bowl 7 standard rounds and 1 position round. If 12 qualify we will bowl 5 games with 4 per pair and 1 position round. If 16 qualify we will bowl 7 games with 4 per pair and 1 position round. There will be no stepladder finals and all pins will carry over. 35 or less entries top 8, 36-47 entries top 12 and 48-59 entries top 16 will make the cut.

John Kreyer Jr Wins US Open for 3rd CBA Title

John Kreyer Jr won the CBA/US Open Qualifying tournament at AMF Saxon Lanes in December and will get the paid entry from the Minnesota Bowling Proprietors to represent Minnesota at the National tournament in February. Not even sure he was going to be able to bowl (his wife was pregnant and the due date was the day of the tournament) Kreyer came prepared to do better than the 2nd place at last years' US Open. Qualifying 3rd on Saturday in the CBA/US Open 12 game format, Kreyer led going into the stepladder finals. The championship match had **Brian Floen** of Rochester trying to stop one of the hottest bowlers in the area. An open frame by Floen in the 6th gave Kreyer an 11 pin lead and all he had to do was get 16 total pins in the 10th to shut out Floen. He filled the 10th with 17 pins and had his 3rd CBA title and 1st US/Open championship.

The first stepladder match had Floen up against **Dan Bock**. Floen finished with 213 and Bock had 209. Next was **Carl Fietek** and a couple of late opens for Fietek gave him 211 to Floen's 176. Floen was then up against **Jeff Smith** and the battle was on. Floen missed once for 279 and Smith needed all 3 in the 10th to tie. He got the first one and nine for 268.

The Qualifying leader was **Chad Nelson** who was trying to become the first CBA bowler to win 3 consecutive tournaments. His score of plus 407 was 41 pins ahead of Fietek for the QL honors. The score to make the cut was 2609 (217 avg) and the cashing score was 2600 (216 avg). The "On Track Cashier" rolloff was won by **Scott Pohl** and the bonus senior cash spots went to **Clark Poelzer** and **Tom Korth**. **Keith Howard** made the cut after winning the On Track cash spot from the last tournament.

Dan Bock had the only 300 game and **Dustin Barr** came close twice with a couple of 299's.

We would like to thank the staff and crew at AMF Saxon Lanes for hosting their tournament.
