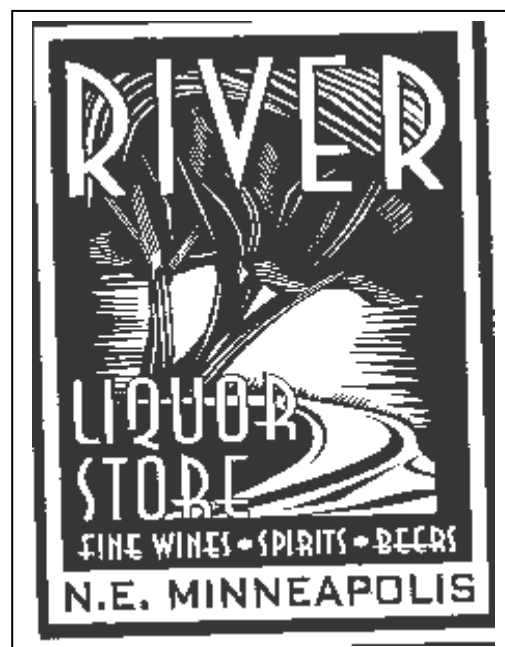

Chad Nelson aka “The Dominator” Wins again for 8th CBA Title

Chad Nelson is “Dominating” the CBA as no one as ever done before. Chad did not bowl the June or July tournaments this season. He bowled August and finished 2nd, Won the Linds Invitational in September, did not cash in October at Alexandria, Won the Doubles with **Dan Bock**, Won the Bloody Mary Open in Eau Claire in November, led the qualifying and finished 7th at the US Open in December and Won this tournament at Midway Pro Bowl in January. That is 4 titles and 1-2nd place finish out of 7 tournaments – Very Impressive!

Qualifying 7th with an average of 219 in our 8 game match play qualifying – 10 bonus pins per match added to score – Nelson averaged 250 for the next 5 games (including a 300 game) to take the lead going in to the position round. **Carl Fietek** who qualified 4th, moved into 2nd, 19 pins behind Nelson. The position round game was going to determine the champion as there would be no stepladder. Nelson started out with strike-spare-four bagger and all Fietek could do was a bunch of spares and finished 2nd to Nelson again as he did in November. Fietek is Dominating the “Bowler of the Year” race as he now has a 13 point lead over John Kreyer Jr and 21 points over Nelson. Fietek was the B.O.Y. last year as well as the following seasons; 2001-2002, 1999-2000, 1998-1999, 1997-1998 and 1993-1994. That is also Very Impressive!

1st time bowler **Matt Beilke** of Hutchinson was the qualifying leader with an average of 233 and won all his qualifying matches for 80 bonus pins. It took a score of 1783 including bonus pins to make the 12 man cut and 1764 to cash. **Dale Seath** and **Jerry Holldorf** won the bonus senior cash spots and **John Kreyer Jr** won the rolloff for the “*On Track Casher*” and a free entry into the February CBA tournament at Granite Bowl South in St Cloud. **Ron Kish** made the finals for the 1st time and **Jason Barnhouse** made his 1st top 5. Luke Voaklander had his 1st CBA 300 in the first game of qualifying.

Thanks again go to CBA Hall of Fame Member **Al Loth**, who also finished 10th and **Scott Koehler** for hosting another CBA tournament.
