One Squad - Paddock: 8:30 AM - Bowling: 9:00 AM

Format: 8 games of qualifying match play with 10 bonus pins per match with the top 8, 12 or 16 (depending on entries) making the cut. They will then bowl standard match play with 30 bonus pins per match. If 8 qualify we will bowl 7 standard rounds and 1 position round. If 12 qualify we will bowl 5 games with 4 per pair and 1 position round. If 16 qualify we will bowl 7 games with 4 per pair and 1 position round. There will be no stepladder finals and all pins will carry over. 35 or less entries top 8, 36-47 entries top 12 and 48-59 entries top 16 will make the cut.

Last Years’ champion, Clark Poelzer and 3 bowlers who had their names drawn at the Hall of Fame banquet, Richard Vitko, Daron Hansen and Loren Lickfelt, will be entered, providing they have 4 tournaments in, and 9 more bowlers will be added by drawing at the Year End tournament.

Dan Bock Goes Wire-to-Wire to Win CBA at Granite Bowl South

Dan Bock wanted all the money and didn't let anyone get in his way as he took charge of the CBA tournament at Granite Bowl South for his 3rd Title. On a demanding condition where it took **190 UNDER** to make the cut Bock was **190 OVER** to lead all 50 bowlers for QL honors on Saturday. Bock took charge on Sunday by winning his first 10 matches and averaging 220 to easily be the leader going into the stepladder finals. He took charge again in the championship match against **Carl Fietek** (who qualified 16th on Saturday) with 7 of the first 9 strikes for an easy 258-194 victory and his 3rd CBA title.

The first stepladder match had **Rob Downer** up against **Luke Voaklander** making his 2nd stepladder finals. Downer was clean and Voaklander had 2 early opens and Downer won a tough match 194-180. Next up was last years' Rookie of the Year **David Oulman** also making his 2nd stepladder finals. A couple of opens had Oulman behind by 20 pins in the 6th and he couldn't catch up as Downer was clean again for a 192-170 victory. In the semifinal match Downer had an open frame in the 6th as Fietek opened the 8th & 9th. Downer needed to double in the 10th to force Fietek to strike out to tie but only managed spare-strike and Fietek needed to fill the frame to advance. Fietek struck and spared to win 214-204.

It took a score of 190 under (190 average) to cash & to make the cut. **Lee Stritesky & Al Bruski** won the bonus senior cash spots and **Tim Hoke** won the rolloff for the "On Track Cashier" for a free entry into the Duluth CBA tournament at Country Lanes North.

The Texas Hold-Em card tournament went over well again as a couple of CBA bowlers made it into the top 5 and quite a few bowlers made it to the Red Carpet for a great night of drinking & dancing.

A huge thank you to **Dave & Mike Bischoff** for hosting the CBA again and to all the local St Cloud bowlers who came out to bowl. We look forward to an even better tournament next year as we will have the CBA in a different month and even have a sweeper on the Friday night before the tournament. Make your plans to go to St Cloud next year for the tournament.
