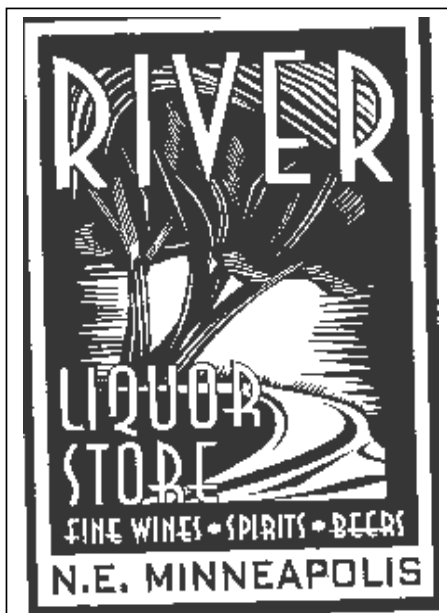

Membership fee is \$40.00 and is due now unless you are bowling for the 1st time.

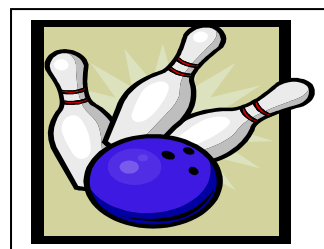
Brackets are still available for \$10.00 each.

The optional \$35.00 prize list will be paid out after qualifying scores at 1 for 3 ratios. You actually don’t have to cash in the tournament to cash in the optional prize list.

Bowlers making the cut ratio will be changed to 1 for 3.

24 bowlers – 8 make the cut
 30 bowlers – 10 make the cut
 36 bowlers – 12 make the cut
 42 bowlers – 14 make the cut
 48 bowlers – 16 make the cut
 54 bowlers – 18 make the cut
 60 bowlers – 20 make the cut
 66 bowlers – 22 make the cut
 72 bowlers or more – 24 make the cut

Cut numbers will depend on lanes available for match play. For example: bowling in a 20 lane house with 66 or more bowlers only 20 will make the cut.



Sam Lantto Wins “Fathers Day Special” for 19th CBA Title

A couple of Fathers with a total of 30 CBA Titles among them, squared off for the title in the CBA at AMF Maple Lanes. **Sam Lantto**, father of 1 daughter and 18 CBA titles, battled **Carl Fietek**, father of 1 son and 12 CBA titles, in the championship match of the June CBA tournament. An early double by Fietek and dutch bowling by Lantto had Fietek ahead by 9 pins in the 4th frame. Lantto showed why he has more CBA titles than anyone by stringing the next 8 strikes to win 260-226 for his 19th title.

The first stepladder match had **Richard Vitko** (who called his father in California) against **Darin Pomije** who has 2 children. A close match through 9 frames had Vitko needing a double in the 10th to win but left a 10-pin and Pomije won 213-189. Up next was **John Kreyer Jr**, father of 1 son and 3 titles in the past season. Another close match had Kreyer Jr also needing a double in the 10th after Pomije struck on the last 5 shots, but he couldn't get he 2nd one as Pomije prevailed 214-210. In the semi-final match Fietek had a couple doubles and an early open by Pomije had Fietek winning easily 235-189.

The Qualifying Leader was **John Kreyer Jr** with a score of 1881 while shooting a 299 game (235 avg) plus 70 bonus pins for a total of 1951. **Dan Bock & Jason Barnhouse** each shot 300 games. **Dustin Musil** (his father was there watching) won the rolloff for the “*On Track Casher*” and a free entry into the July CBA Tournament. **Ron Lindner** was the Bonus Senior casher with a score of 1717 (214 avg) plus 50 bonus pins for a total of 1767. Our new entry fee brought in 43 bowlers with a total of 19 getting into the Optional Qualifying prize list, Kreyer Jr won an extra \$215 for leading while we paid out a total of 6 spots.

Paul Mielens had his father watching him (even though he left for a while), **Don Eller's** son was there, watching **Joel Johnson's** father came to see him bowl, **Brent Stearns'** father watched, **Jason Barnhouse's** father **Chuck** also bowled and made the cut, **Luke Voaklander** brought his brothers **Dan & Mark** to bowl and their father **Dave** watched all day and my daughter came down to see me while bringing my 3 ½ year grandson along. All in All a Great “*Fathers Day Special*”.

The CBA would like to thank **David Langer**, father of 1 daughter, and **Ken Worm**, also a father, for their hospitality in hosting our CBA tournament.
