The 12th annual CBA Hall of Fame and Awards banquet will be held at Cedarvale Lanes on Saturday October 29th after the completion of the Baker Doubles qualifying. **Jeff Smith** will be inducted for Superior Performance. We will be honoring all CBA champions from the past year and also the members of the All Star teams, Bowler of the Year, Rookie of the Year, John Dorek Award winner, Jim Lindquist high average award winner and the Bob Hanson Sportsmanship Award winner. The dinner is free to all CBA members; cost for guests is \$10. We will also have a drawing for 3 spots for the **RIVER LIQUOR STORE SHOOTOUT** at the May Year-End tournament. Defending shootout champion **Tim Hoke** already has a spot for the shootout. There will be door prizes that everyone will have a chance to win, so make sure you show up and congratulate everyone on their accomplishments.

Randy Bartz Wins at Flaherty's for 3rd CBA Title – 21 Years 7 Months After his 2nd

Randy Bartz figured enough time had gone by since his last win so he might as well get another title. With his last title coming in February 1984 at Cedarvale Lanes, Bartz started bowling the CBA a little more regularly the last couple of years. Going up the stepladder Bartz had to face one of the CBA's best in **Chad Nelson** for the title. Nelson started the match with strike-spare-four-bagger while Bartz started with spare-double-spare, but then struck on his next 6 shots. Nelson, needing the first two in the 10th, left a light 7-pin on the first shot to give Bartz the championship 254-237. Only **Bruce Forsland** had a greater distance between titles – 22 years 2 months.

The stepladder started with Bartz facing former Rookie of the Year **Ben Goede**. An early four-bagger and late turkey by Bartz gave him an easy win 246-214. Bartz then had to face former Bowler of the Year and current points leader, **Dan Bock**. He again started strong with a double-spare-double while Bock had a little trouble and Bartz moved on with a 212-170 win. The semifinal match had Bartz facing **Chris Charles**, who was making his first ever CBA stepladder. This time Bartz had a little trouble early with 2 opens in the first seven frames while Charles opened in the 5th & 8th. A late double put Bartz ahead and Charles could have struck out in the 10th to win but only managed one and Bartz won 191-182.

Dan Bock was the Qualifying Leader for the second straight tournament while averaging 233 and winning 6 of 8 matches for the eight games and shooting a 300. It took a score of 1887 (plus 287 with bonus pins) to make the cut and cash. **Jason Smith** won the \$50 high game award with a 300 and **Joe Cairl** had the other honor score with a 299. **Richard Vitko** won the rolloff for the On Track Casher and also picked up the 7-10 split during qualifying.

The CBA would like to thank Flaherty's Arden Bowl's proprietor **Dan Flaherty**, Manager **Brian Hove**, Assistant Manager **Dean Streich** and their staff for hosting our tournament.
