Dan Bock “Holds Em” off for Fourth CBA Title

Dan Bock, fresh from a 13th place finish at the USBC Masters, held off the competition in the 2nd Annual Texas “Hold Em” tournament at Granite Bowl south in St Cloud. Starting a little slow during qualifying on Saturday, Bock qualified 13th for the match play. He made the most of it by staying towards the top during the 12 match play games on Sunday and ended up in the 2nd position for the stepladder. After disposing of **Luke Voaklander** in the semifinal match 226-182, Bock found himself needing to fill the 10th frame of the championship match against **Jeff Smith** for the victory. He calmly threw a strike to win 220-203 for his fourth CBA title, 2nd in a row at Granite Bowl South, and increased his lead for Bowler of the Year.

The first stepladder match had the reigning CBA Bowler of the Year, **Carl Fietek** against Voaklander. Voaklander started with a four-bagger and won easily 222-193. The next match had Voaklander up against Rochester’s **Tim Mayer** and although both bowlers had clean games, Voaklander had a double and won 226-182.

The qualifying leader was **Chad Nelson** with a score of plus 244 (224 avg) while it took plus 69 (206 avg) to cash and make the cut as 18 bowlers competed on Sunday. The only honor score of the weekend was Voaklander with a 300. **Corey Flynn** won the “*On Track Casher*” Rolloff for the free entry into the December US Open tournament.

24 bowlers competed in the Friday night sweeper at Granite Bowl downtown and **Ben Goede** held off **Dave Bischoff** for the win. The Texas “Hold Em” tournament on Saturday night was a big success and **Cheryl Nelson**, who finished in 11th place, was the highest finish of the CBA entrants.

The CBA would like to thank **Mike & Dave Bischoff** and their staff for hosting a successful CBA weekend. A great time was had by all as there was plenty going on at the Red Carpet if you weren’t at the card game.
