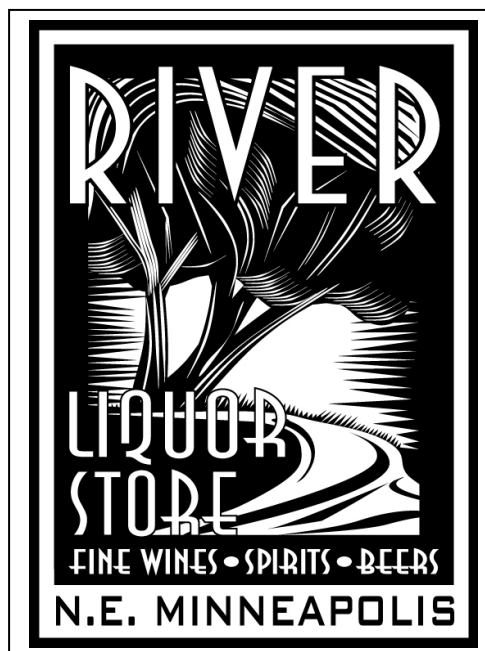

## Matt Meyer Wins at the New Garden Center Lanes for First CBA Title

Alexandria's **Matt Meyer** showed his stuff as he took on the CBA's hottest bowler in the past couple years to win his first CBA title at the October stop at the New Garden Center Lanes. Meyer faced the reigning Bowler of the Year and current leader, Albert Lea's **Dan Bock** in the position round and eked out a 236-235 win to hold the top spot in the stepladder and waited to meet Bock again in the championship game. Meyer started out the match with a four-bagger but a double and late turkey by Bock had the match within 10 pins in the 9<sup>th</sup> frame. With a strike-spare finish by Bock, Meyer needed spare-strike to win. Growing up in the bowling business, Meyer knew that a strike was the best thing to do and he absolutely flushed the first one in the 10<sup>th</sup> for a 225-215 victory.

The first stepladder match had Owatonna's **Chad Nelson** up against Albert Lea's **Dustin Barr**. With Barr striking from the 4<sup>th</sup> through the 10<sup>th</sup>, Nelson didn't have much of a chance and Barr went on to win 245-171. Barr then had to face another Alexandria bowler in **Clayton Mohr** and while Mohr had a couple opens, Barr was clean for a 216-162 victory. Barr was clean again in the next game but bowling against Bock was a tough assignment and he couldn't match the strikes Bock was getting as Bock put him away 245-217 to set the stage for the championship.

The Qualifying Leader was CBA Hall of Fame member **Jeff Smith** of Little Falls who shot 2326 (232 avg) for the 10 games. It took a score of 2077 (207 avg) to cash and make the cut and Mankato's **Tom Korth** was the bonus senior casher. Dustin Barr was also the last cash in the optional qualifying with a score of 2082. **John Kreyer Jr** of Fridley won the 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame eliminator rolloff for the "**On Track Casher**" and a free entry into the November CBA tournament.

Only 4 seniors bowled this tournament and with **Ron Lindner** of Mayer making the cut and Tom Korth taking the bonus senior cash spot, 2 of the 4 cashed.

Special thanks to **Charlie Meyer** and the whole Meyer family along with the staff at Garden Center Lanes for their hospitality in hosting our CBA tournament.

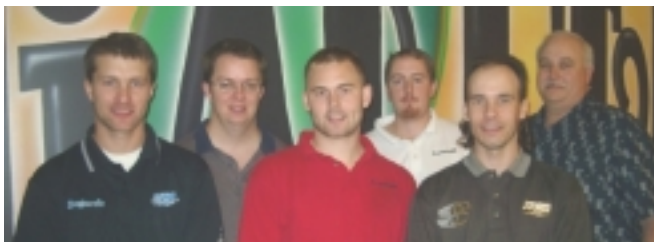
