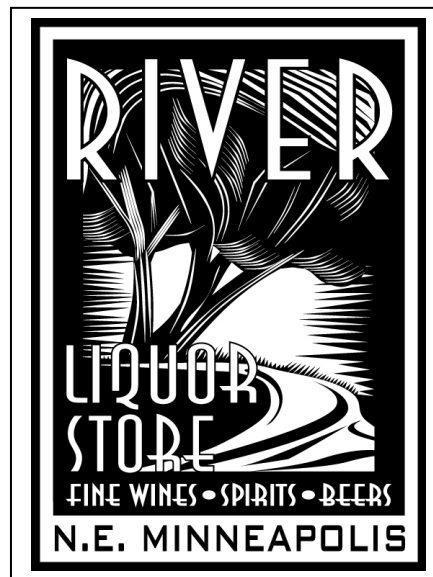

## Dan Bock Takes Lead In Mikes Pro Shop Points Challenge With Win at Linds Invitational

**Dan Bock**, the reigning CBA Bowler of the Year and Mikes Pro Shop CBA Points Challenge Champion, takes the early lead in the points challenge championship by winning the Linds Invitational at River City Lanes. Bock had to face one of the best in CBA Hall of Famer **Jeff Smith** in the championship match and started with spare-turkey-spare while Smith had a double and three straight 7 pins. While Smith was picking up spares, Bock was striking and won handily 248-214 for his 5<sup>th</sup> CBA title while getting very close to the 200 points needed for the CBA Hall of Fame.

**Chad Nelson** and **Ron Lindner** started the stepladder with Lindner probably wanting to forget about it. The pair didn't seem to fit Lindner's game and Nelson rolled 219-157. Next up for Nelson was teammate **Tom Korth**, who is one point behind **Carl Fietek** for the early Bowler of the Year points lead, and Nelson didn't give Korth a chance as he had the last nine for a 268-223 victory. Up next for Nelson was Bock, another teammate and doubles partner. Nelson seemed to have the match in hand until a split in the 9<sup>th</sup> frame had the match within 5 pins. Bock needed the first strike to shut out Nelson but left a 7-pin and spared, Nelson then needed to double but a solid 7 stopped him and Bock went on to the championship match with a 237-231 win.

This was the 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Linds Invitational (previously called the Linds Tournament of Champions for 6 years) and we had a great turnout of 50 bowlers while **Mark Parnell** of River City Lanes added \$500 to go along with the \$750 from Linds. It took a score of 2166 (216 avg) to cash & make the cut while it took 2201 (220 avg) to cash in the optional. **Jason Wagner** was the Qualifying Leader with 2361 (236 avg). Once again we had 23 bowlers in the 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame eliminator rolloff for the "*On Track Casher*" and **Mike Skinner** prevailed for the free entry into the October CBA tournament at Garden Center Lanes. **Mark Parnell** was the Bonus Senior Casher with a score of 2158 (215 avg). Once again we had two seniors (Korth & Lindner) in the stepladder.

Special thanks go out the **Jeff Lind & David Wiggins** from the Lind Shoe Company for their sponsoring of our CBA tournaments along with **Mark Parnell** and his staff at River City Lanes. Looking forward to the NEW River City Lanes next year.

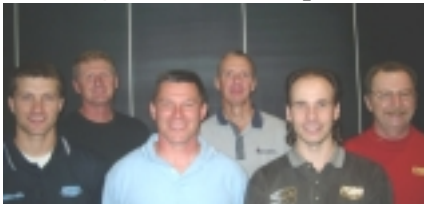
