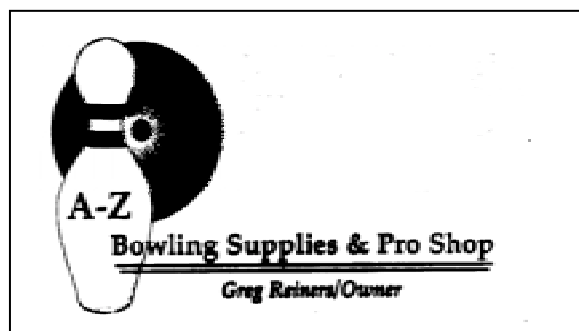

Bowling ball for raffle is donated by A-Z Pro Shops. Proceeds from the January & February raffle will go towards the expenses for the U S Open tournament.



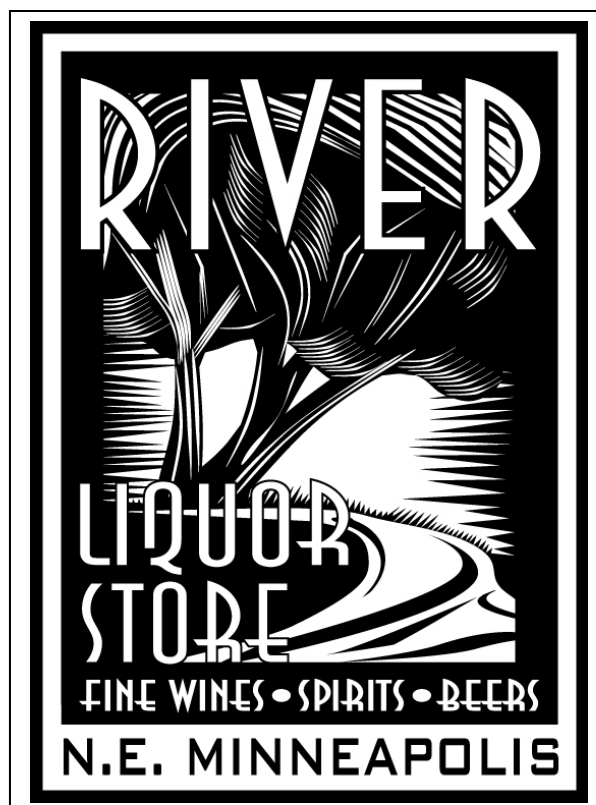

All bowlers must have their names and CBA logos on their shirts for both days and no bowlers are allowed to wear jeans on Sundays. A \$10.00 fine will be issued for bowlers late for paddock on Sunday. Paddock is always at 7:40 AM.

The 2006-2007 Year End CBA will be held at Cedarvale Lanes in Eagan. Bowlers must be a member for this season and have bowled in 4 tournaments to be eligible. The payout will be 1 for 2 and there will be approximately \$4000 Added Money for this tournament.

River Liquor Store is again sponsoring the Shootout with a \$500 donation and another \$500 will be added from the bracket proceeds. 13 bowlers will compete in the shootout. Last Years' champion, Dan Bock and 3 bowlers who had their names drawn at the Hall of Fame banquet, David Langer, Dan Langer and Carl Fietek, will be entered and 9 more bowlers will be added by drawing from the non cashers at the Year End tournament. The bowlers already entered into the shootout must have 4 tournaments in to be eligible.



David Langer Does It Right For 7th CBA Title

David Langer of Brooklyn Park did things the right way as he held off Rochester's **Brian Floen** in the championship match of the CBA tournament at Double "A" Lanes in Hilltop, MN. Being in the right place at the right time, Langer made Floen finish on the right lane needing strike-spare to win or nine-spare-strike to tie. Floen couldn't get it right as he went nine-spare-nine to fall one pin short 238-237 and Langer had his 7th CBA title and 2nd of the year.

The first stepladder match had Floen against first time stepladder finalist **Nick Larson** of Circle Pines. Larson had a hard time getting things right as he struggled to a 170 game to Floen's 236. Floen was right on in the next game as he faced another first time stepladder finalist in **Matt Steffenson** of Strum, WI, and easily put him away 280-200. Fridley's **John Kreyer Jr**, who has been getting it right quite often in the last few tournaments, had a little trouble late in the semi final match and Floen came away with a 228-190 win to set the stage for the championship match. Langer got things done right in the position round game, 16th game of the day, as he shot 259 to Kreyer Jr's 192 to overtake him for the top spot in the stepladder.

51 bowlers started the 8 game match play qualifying tournament and it took a score of 1699 (212 avg) plus 60 bonus pins to make the top 16 cut. **Robert Walker** of Isanti, bowling in his 2nd CBA tournament, took 17th and last cash with 1686 (210 avg) including a 300 game for the only honor score of the tournament. Mankato's **Tom Korth** was the bonus senior casher with 1671 (208 avg) and another Mankato bowler, **Ken Holets**, won the 9th & 10th frame eliminator rolloff for the "On Track Casher" and a free entry into the February tournament at Holiday Lanes in Albert Lea. Qualifying Leader was John Kreyer Jr with a score of 2012 (251 avg) plus 70 bonus pins.

We had 7 first time bowlers in **Matt Steffenson, Brian Janke, Tom Roberts, John Roberts, Mike Holzhueter, Tom Kasper Jr & Steve Wold** and 4 bowlers in their 2nd tournament; **Charlie Moore, Billy Clarin, Robert Walker & Kris Stevens**.

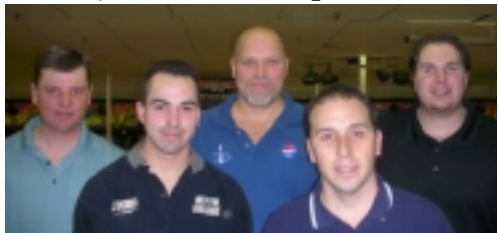
