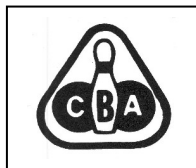

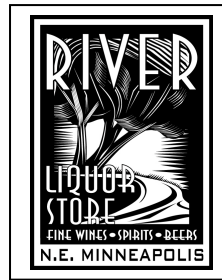

Chad Nelson to be Inducted*

The 14th annual CBA Hall of Fame and Awards banquet will be held at Wells Lanes on Saturday October 27th after the completion of the Baker Doubles qualifying. **Chad Nelson** will be inducted for Superior Performance. We will be honoring all CBA champions from the past year and also the members of the All Star teams, Bowler of the Year, Rookie of the Year, John Dorek Award winner, Jim Lindquist high average award winner and the Bob Hanson Sportsmanship Award winner. The dinner is **Free** to all CBA members; cost for guests is \$10. There will be door prizes that everyone will have a chance to win, so make sure you show up and congratulate everyone on their accomplishments.

Mikes Pro Shop CBA Points Challenge

The Linds Invitational in September is the first leg of the Mikes Pro Shop CBA Points Challenge. The other 3 tournaments are the November tournament in St Cloud, the US Open in December and the Year End in May. The bowler with the most points garnered for these 4 tournaments will win the \$300.00 prize from Mikes Pro Shop. This is the 5th year for this and the two time defending champion is Dan Bock while the first 2 were won by Chad Nelson.

Ron Kish Wins At New Hope Bowl for 1st CBA Title

Ron Kish, the current CBA Ironman having bowled in 52 consecutive tournaments, came out victorious at the July CBA tournament at New Hope Bowl. Bowling in his first championship game, Kish came out strong with a turkey while his veteran opponent **Richard Vitko** couldn't seem to carry the 10 pin. Kish kept the pressure on after opening in the 4th with a four-bagger to Vitko's 9 spare-strike-9 spare-strike in frames 4 through 7. Kish calmly closed out the match with a couple spares to win 231-203 for his first CBA title. Qualifying in the 12th and last position, Kish made a big move to be the 2nd seed in the stepladder. Ron came out of juniors in August of 2003 and has bowled every CBA tournament since, trying to pass the record of 125 consecutive tournaments once bowled by Iron **Mike Wirz** of Eau Claire, WI. Ron also became the first "**On Track Casher**" to win a tournament. Perseverance definitely pays off. This was Vitko's 4th runner up finish.

The first stepladder match had June's champion, **Ron Lindner**, matched up against another senior in **Tom Korth**. A very close match had Korth needing to mark in the 10th to win and he doubled to move on 212-199. Up next for Korth was his teammate **Rob Clements** and this was a strike fest. Korth started out with the front 7 while Clements had spare-five bagger and then left a solid 9. Korth spared in the 8th and Clements struck out from the 8th to force Korth to double again to win. He, of course, did to win 276-267. Korth then had to take on Kish and had some trouble striking as Kish put him away 214-192.

Qualifying Leader was senior bowler and current points leader Ron Lindner with a score of 1853 (231 avg) plus 70 bonus pins. It took a score of 1756 (219) plus 50 bonus pins to make the top 12 cut. **Tim Hoke** won the bonus senior cash spot and **Chad Nelson** went through the 9th & 10th frame eliminator rolloff to win the "**On Track Casher**" and a free entry into the August tournament. The two seniors are the top point leaders as Ron Lindner has 44 points and Tom Korth 34 after the first 2 tournaments of the 2007-2008 season.

The CBA would like to thank **Greg Bender** and his staff at New Hope Bowl for their hospitality in hosting our CBA tournament and we look forward to going there again next year.

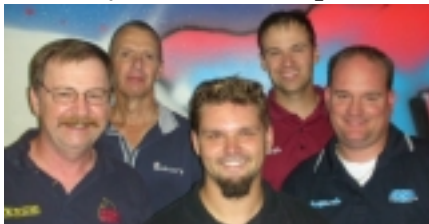
