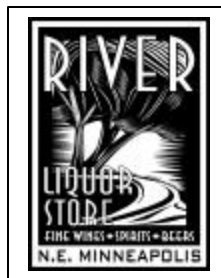

Rob Downer & Brian Floen Head to CBA Hall of Fame After Baker Doubles Victory

Rob Downer & Brian Floen won their 2nd CBA doubles title together (having won the best ball tournament in 1993) and now both have enough points to be inducted into the CBA Hall of Fame. Downer will be inducted in 2008 and Floen in 2010 while **Dan Bock** will go in in 2009. Downer & Floen as the #1 seed in the stepladder had to face the tough duo of **Robert Slayton & Sam Sylvester Jr.** in the 2 game baker match. The first game had lots of strikes by both teams as Downer/Floen had 257 to Slayton/Sylvester's 248. With Slayton/Sylvester opening the 2nd frame with a split, Downer/Floen ran off 4 strikes after a spare and cruised 238-211 for a match total of 495-459.

The first stepladder match had **Jeff Smith** and **Barry Zimmerman** up against the veteran team of **Al Loth & Clark Poelzer** who were bowling their 25th consecutive doubles tournament together (winning the first tournament in 1983). A couple of early opens by Smith/Zimmerman and the last 8 of the first game and front 7 of the 2nd game had Loth/Poelzer winning easily 522-419. The formidable duo of **Dan Bock & Chad Nelson** were up next for Loth/Poelzer and after a close first game 227-216, Bock/Nelson ran off the front 9 in the 2nd game and took the match 504-443. Slayton/Sylvester were a tough match as it came down to the 10th frame of the 2nd game and Sylvester needed a mark to win. A solid strike gave them the match 452-437.

A total of 53 teams competed in this years' tournament and Bock/Nelson were the Qualifying Leaders with a 16 game baker total of 3777 (236 avg). It took a score of 3553 (222 avg) by **Kris Geister & Lisa Noor** to make the cut and 3494 (218 avg) by the Super Senior duo of **Roger Blad & Jim Lindquist** to cash. The bonus senior cash spot went to On Track's Gary Arntzen & **Leif Carlson** while the bonus woman casher was won by the sisters - **Deb Lantto & Lisa Nadeau**.

The CBA Hall of Fame & Awards Banquet had another great turnout as **Chad Nelson** was inducted into the Hall for Superior Performance and the champions & all star teams from the past season were presented with their trophies. **Dan Bock** won the Bowler of the Year award for the 2nd consecutive season and 3rd overall, while also collecting the **John Dorek** Award for the most money won and the **Jim Lindquist** award for having the highest average. **Tom Korth** won the **Bob Hanson** Sportsmanship award for the 2nd time. **Seth Bonow** took home the Rookie of the Year award.

We would like to thank our hosts, CBA members **Brent Prentice & Craig McDonald** for hosting yet another great tournament and banquet.
