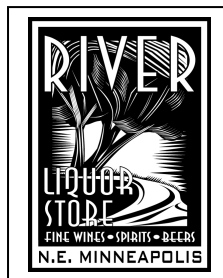

The 14th annual CBA Hall of Fame and Awards banquet will be held at Wells Lanes on Saturday October 25th after the completion of the Baker Doubles qualifying. **Rob Downer** will be inducted for Superior Performance. We will be honoring all CBA champions from the past year and also the members of the All Star teams, Bowler of the Year, Rookie of the Year, John Dorek Award winner, Jim Lindquist high average award winner and the Bob Hanson Sportsmanship Award winner. The dinner is **Free** to all CBA members; cost for guests is \$10. There will be door prizes that everyone will have a chance to win, so make sure you show up and congratulate everyone on their accomplishments.

Mikes Pro Shop CBA Points Challenge

The Linds Invitational in September is the first leg of the Mikes Pro Shop CBA Points Challenge. The other 3 tournaments are the November tournament at Matties, the US Open in December and the Year End in May. The bowler with the most points garnered for these 4 tournaments will win the \$300.00 prize from Mikes Pro Shop. This is the 6th year Mike has sponsored the points challenge and our defending champion is John Kreyer Jr.



Record Setting Performance by Chad Nelson Nets him 12th CBA Title

Chad Nelson became the first bowler in CBA history to win 3 consecutive tournaments by coming out victorious at the August 2008 CBA stop at Mermaid Lanes. Qualifying in 7th position after 8 games and then taking over the top spot after the 6 games of round robin match play, Nelson waited while **Tom Korth** was moving through the stepladder to face him. Nelson was not going to let this one get away as he started with 3 strikes and 4-nine pin spares as Korth was having trouble. Nelson had a 56 pin lead in the 7th and cruised to a 235-169 victory. There have been 16 other bowlers to win back-to-back titles including Sam Lantto & Dave Hoppenrath who had done it twice. Nelson had won back-to-back titles once before also.

The first stepladder match had first time bowler, youth bowler **Richard Novak**, up against **Matt Wratz** who was bowling in his 2nd CBA tournament after finishing last in the previous one. A dogfight until the end as both bowlers matched 5-baggers and then Wratz opened the door and Novak took charge to win 244-215. Up next for Novak was Senior Bowler and Qualifying Leader Korth. A tough match had Novak needing to double in the 10th to win but left a ripped 7 on the first shot and Korth prevailed 180-172. 3-time defending bowler of the year, **Dan Bock**, was up next and Korth took off with a five-bagger in the middle of the game to move on 235-193.

Qualifying Leader, Korth, was at 1774 (221 avg) after the 8 games of qualifying on the 2008 USBC pattern while it took 1605 (200 avg) to cash & make the cut. The bonus senior cash spot went to **Chuck Barnhouse** at 1581 (197 avg) while another senior bowler, **Clark Poelzer**, held off all bowlers in the 9th & 10th frame eliminator rolloff to win the *"On Track Casher"* and a free entry into the next CBA tournament.

Other first time bowlers were **Justin Anderson, Jesse Inderlee, Daren Seney, Matt Smallin** and **Devin Walter**.

The CBA would like to thank General Manager **Greg Reiners** and his staff for their hospitality in hosting our tournament. Also to A-Z pro shop for donating the bowling bag for the raffle.
