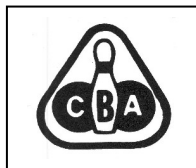

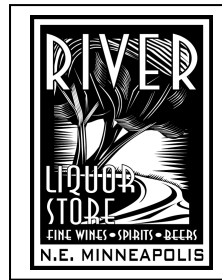

The May 9 & 10 CBA tournament is our Year End Tournament where we have approximately \$4000 ADDED MONEY. You must be a CBA member and have bowled in 4 tournaments in the current season to qualify. The cash ratio is 1 for 2 and we also have the River Liquor Store Shootout. It is also the final leg of the Mikes Pro Shop CBA Points Challenge. Make sure you get your 4 tournaments in to qualify for this tournament.

We have now added another sponsor to the year end tournament. Aaron & Dan Barnhouse and their company Barnhouse Exteriors will sponsor a new shootout.

This will be called the **Barnhouse Exteriors “Full Sody” Shootout.**

In case you don't know the “Full Sody” is when you leave the 3-4-6-7-9-10 pins (opposite for left handers) on your fist shot. This is because Sody is the only bowler I know to leave this after the front 11 for a 294 score. We're not sure of the exact format yet but *Barnhouse Exteriors* will pay \$300 for 1st - \$200 for 2nd & \$100 for 3rd.

Travel south on Hwy. 52, then east on Hwy. 55 to U.S. 61, or travel south on U.S. 61 all the way from the Twin Cities to Hastings. On the south side of Hastings travel south on Hwy. 316 to 200th St. Follow 200th St. for 8 miles and pass over the Etter Bridge.

Valentine's Day Massacre at Holiday Lanes – Chad Nelson Wins Again

Chad Nelson is continuing his *Massacre* of the 2008-2009 CBA Season as he won his 5th title of the year and 14th overall by winning the Valentine's Day tournament at Holiday Lanes in Albert Lea. Qualifying 3rd with a score of (1889 236 avg including a 300 in the 2nd game) after the 8 games of qualifying in our one day carry over pins with stepladder tournament, Nelson *massacred* the pins during the match play. By averaging 246 in the match play Nelson took the top spot in the stepladder over **Rob Downer** (who had a 300 game in the 3rd game of qualifying) by 111 pins. Bowling against current *CBA Iron Man* **Ron Kish** in the championship match, Nelson started the massacre by striking in the 1st and then a 5-bagger in frames 4 through 8 to win 238-216 and cruise to his 14th CBA title. Nelson & Kish were bowling with some old equipment they found in their basements as they just got back from the USBC Masters and their equipment hadn't arrived yet.

The first stepladder match had the CBA bowler with the million revs who massacres the pins every shot he throws, **Jeff Walther**, bowling against Kish. The only problem Walther had was that he was massacring the pins on his 2nd ball as he was clean for 196 but Kish took care of him with a 219. Kish did his own massacre of the pins in the semi final match against Downer by winning 268-237.

3 – time defending CBA Bowler of the Year, **Dan Bock** massacred the pins during qualifying with a score of 1950 (243 avg) to lead qualifying while it took a score of 1808 (226 avg) to make the cut and 1805 (225.6 avg) to cash. **Jason Lee** came away with the On Track Casher by holding off everyone in the 9th & 10th frame eliminator rolloff for a free entry into the April CBA tournament. Super Senior **Ron Lindner** won the bonus senior cash spot with a score of 1753 (219 avg).

Chad Nelson is about to massacre the season points record of 225 points set by **Carl Fietek** during the 2004-05 season. With 192 points through 10 tournaments, Nelson is on a pace for 249 points.

We would like to thank Holiday Lanes proprietors **Dustin Barr & Loren Kaiser** for hosting our CBA tournament.

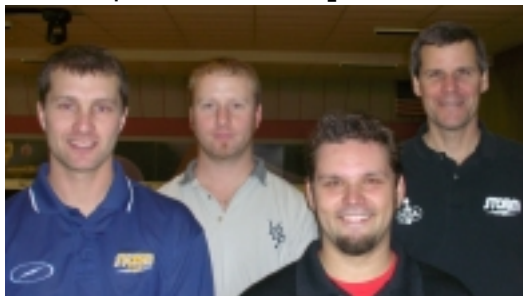
