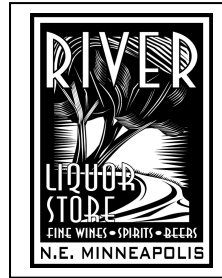

The 2008-2009 Year End CBA will be held at Cedarvale Lanes in Eagan. Bowlers must be a member for this season and have bowled in 4 tournaments to be eligible. The payout will be 1 for 2 and there will be approximately \$4000 Added Money for this tournament.

## Linds Teammates – Fietek & Prentice – Win Alternate Shot Doubles

Linds Teammates **Carl Fietek & Brent Prentice** thought they would gamble and team up for the Alternate Shot CBA Doubles tournament at Island Xtreme Bowl at Treasure Island Resort & Casino and showed it wasn't much of a gamble, as they came away with a hard fought victory against the 3 time CBA doubles duo in **David & Dan Langer**. With the championship match being video taped by MNBowling.com, the 2 teams showed why they were at the top. The Langers had a little trouble getting more than 9 spare while Fietek was striking and picking up Prentice's single pins for a 236-207 1<sup>st</sup> game score. A crucial 2<sup>nd</sup> frame for the Langers where Dan left a 4-9 split and David didn't convert got them further in the hole especially when Prentice broke up a split and left an easy spare for Fietek. From then on Fietek/Prentice didn't miss and shot 279 to 236 for a 2 game match total of 515-443 and the 16<sup>th</sup> CBA title for Fietek and 2<sup>nd</sup> for Prentice.

The 1st match had **Ben Goede & Dave Bordson** against the points leaders **Chad Nelson & Dan Bock**. Nelson/Bock proved too much with a steady 2 games of 214 & 215 for 429 to 212 & 179 for 381. Up next were fellow Bogart's teammates **Bob Hager & Tom Korth** and Nelson/Bock had to show them who was better as they stepped up their game to shoot 244 & 257 for 501 to 208 & 215 for 423. Nelson/Bock had to face some more Bogart's teammates in the Langers and the match was very close. Nelson/Bock had 225 to the Langers 212 in the 1<sup>st</sup> game but the Langers came back the 2<sup>nd</sup> game with a 246 for a 2 game total of 458. Nelson needed the first strike in the 10<sup>th</sup> of the 2<sup>nd</sup> game but left a solid 8 and shot 221 for a 2 game total of 446.

**Al Loth & Clark Poelzer** won the bonus senior cash spot and **Kris Geister & Karyn Beckjorden** won the bonus woman cash spot. The Langers took the top spot during the 16 game Saturday qualifying with a score of 3727 (232 avg) while it took a score of 3311 (9206 avg) to cash and make the cut.

**Chad Nelson** continues his pursuit of the CBA single season points record with his 3<sup>rd</sup> place finish getting him 21 points to give him a total of 213 through 11 tournaments. The single season record is 225 set by **Carl Fietek** during the 2004-05 season.
