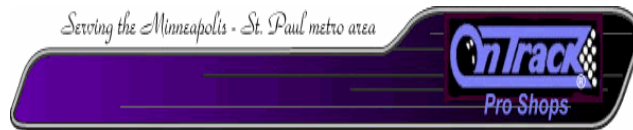

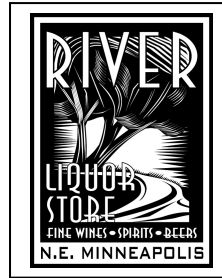

The 17th annual CBA Hall of Fame and Awards banquet will be held at Cedarvale Lanes on Saturday October 31st after the completion of the Baker Doubles qualifying. **Dan Bock** will be inducted for Superior Performance. We will be honoring all CBA champions from the past year and also the members of the All Star teams, Bowler of the Year, Rookie of the Year, John Dorek Award winner, Jim Lindquist high average award winner and the Bob Hanson Sportsmanship Award winner. The dinner is **Free** to all CBA members; cost for guests is \$13. There will be door prizes that everyone will have a chance to win, so make sure you show up and congratulate everyone on their accomplishments.

Mikes Pro Shop CBA Points Challenge

The Linds Invitational in September is the first leg of the Mikes Pro Shop CBA Points Challenge. The other 3 tournaments are the November tournament at Brunswick Zone, Lakeville, the US Open in December and the Year End in April. The bowler with the most points garnered for these 4 tournaments will win the \$300.00 prize from Mikes Pro Shop. This is the 7th year Mike has sponsored the points challenge and our defending champion is Jeff Smith.

A Tough Battle Nets Matt McNeil First CBA Title

Matt McNeil had perhaps the toughest battle in his young career and came through with flying colors to win the August CBA tournament at Texa Tonka Lanes. Bowling against the reigning CBA Bowler of the Year, **Chad Nelson**, McNeil was fighting hard to keep under control and make good shots. A 4-9 split by Nelson in the 4th and a double by McNeil in the 4th & 5th frames had McNeil ahead by 21 pins in the 5th. Nelson was not going down easy though as he kept plugging away on the constantly changing and tough lane condition. Nelson kept firing the ball into the 1-3 pocket but only managed 2 more strikes along with 5 – 9 count spares to finish with a 184. McNeil had opened in the 7th and suddenly the match was down to McNeil needing to mark in the 10th to win. His first shot drifted high for a 2-4-7-8 leave and needed to pick up arguably the toughest spare to win. With the 8 pin falling last he had the spare and then struck to win 192- to Nelson's 184 and his 1st CBA title.

The first match had McNeil up against the 2007-2008 CBA Rookie of the Year **Ryan Burr**, who was making his first ever stepladder appearance. McNeil had to show what he was made of by having to strike out in the 10th to tie at 182. What followed was 4 – 9th & 10th frame *On Track Casher* rollofs where each bowler alternated going last until McNeil finally came through with a 60-39 win. Next for McNeil was **Brandon Fietek** who was making his 2nd stepladder appearance in a row in only his 2nd CBA tournament. Both bowlers started with the front 5 and then a solid 7 and solid 9 by Fietek in the 6th & 7th frames and 2 more strikes by McNeil had him winning 256-230. Up next was 3 time Bowler of the Year **Dan Bock** and McNeil wasn't letting up as he was striking early for a big lead and went on to win 237-167.

Chad Nelson was the Qualifying Leader with an 8-game score of 1849 (231 avg) while it took a score of 1717 (214 avg) to make the cut and cash. **Ron Lindner** beat out **Ron Kish** in a one game rolloff for 16th place making Kish the last casher. **Tom Korth** won the bonus senior cash spot and **Deb Lantto** took home the bonus woman casher.

Eric Schacht won the free entry for the September tournament by winning the 9th & 10th frame *On Track Casher* rolloff. **Matt McNeil** had a 300 in the 6th game of match play while **Nick Belden**, bowling in his 1st CBA tournament and with his son watching, shot 300 in his first ever CBA game.

We would like to thank our host proprietors **Jeff Kristal**, **Bill Johnson** and **Steve Trickey** for hosting our tournament.
