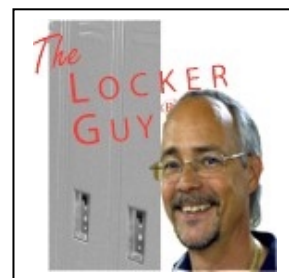
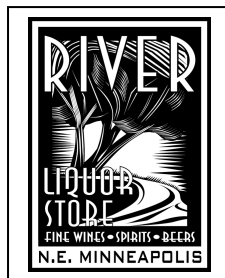

Dan Bock Wins U S Open for 10th CBA Title at Granite Bowl South

Albert Lea's **Dan Bock** finally broke the double digit title barrier by winning the US Open on the demanding condition put out by Granite Bowl South in St Cloud. Taking on St Cloud's "Rev Master" **Jeff Walther** in the title match, Bock showed his Hall of Fame ability by putting on the pressure at the end of the match. Both bowlers started with a turkey and then 2 open frames by Walther had Bock ahead by 17 in the 5th. Bock was leading by 26 in the 8th and then threw a double to close out the match for his 10th CBA victory and 1st US Open win.

The first stepladder match had **Jason Barnhouse** of Colorado (formerly of Maple Grove) taking on the above named "Rev Master". A couple early opens by Barnhouse had him down by 20 pins in the 4th but he then managed a turkey to pull within 10 until Walther revved it up for a 6-bagger and a 226-178 victory. Brooklyn Park's **David Langer** was up next and a tough match was in store for Walther. After starting with a turkey, Langer then left the "full sody", 2-10 and 2-4-10 for 3 consecutive opens and was behind by 30 in the 6th. Walther, meanwhile, had 3 opens of his own but also 2 doubles and won 179-161. Walther figured something out in the next match against Alexandria's **Matt Meyer** by string the last 10 for a 269-242 victory.

David Langer was the Saturday qualifying leader with a 10 game score of 2250 (225 avg) while it took 1951 (195.1) average to make the cut. **Chad Huikko** beat **Ron Kish** in a one game rolloff 186-174 for the 12th match play spot and Ryan Burr was the last cash at 1943 (194.3 avg). **Ron Lindner** just missed cashing but did get the Bonus Senior cash spot at 1940 (194.0 avg) and **Kara Bischoff** won the Bonus Woman cash spot at 1806. **Dave Oulman**, last years US Open Champion, won the 9th & 10th frame eliminator rolloff for the "On Track Casher" and a free entry into the January tournament.

We would like to thank Granite Bowl Proprietor **Mike Bischoff**, General Manager **Jeff Cypher** and Manager **Ben Goede** for putting out the tough US Open condition.

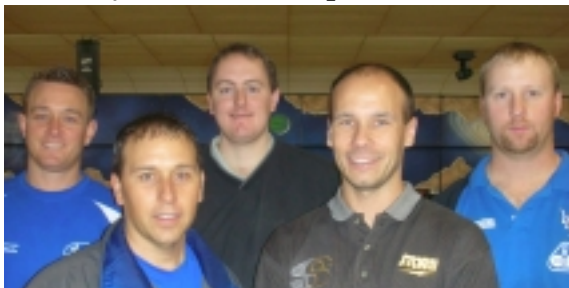
