16 qualifying games of baker system bowling on Saturday, with the top 12 teams making the cut to Sunday match play. Sunday match play consists of 2 game matches with 15 bonus pins per game and 20 bonus pins per match followed by a 5 team stepladder.

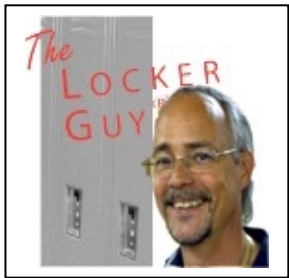
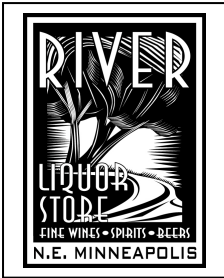

## “Imagine” David Langer Wins Another CBA Title

**David Langer** had “*Instant Karma*” on the lanes as he came through with a “*Cold Turkey*” late in the title match against **John Kreyer Jr** to win his 12<sup>th</sup> CBA title at the October tournament at Island Xtreme Bowl. Bowling on the Kegel “*Abbey Road*” pattern (in honor of John Lennon’s 70<sup>th</sup> birthday this month) the championship match was a battle for both bowlers as neither wanted to give the other a chance for victory. Kreyer Jr needed a “*Cold Turkey*” of his own in the 10<sup>th</sup> to “*Hold On*” for the victory but only managed spare-strike. Langer had everything “*Come Together*” in the 10<sup>th</sup> as he needed to fill with good count and did with 9-spares-strike for a 214-210 victory. It will be a “*Happy Xmas*” at the Langer household this year with the “*Money (that’s what I want)*” he won for winning the tournament.

The first stepladder match had “rookie of the year” point’s leader, **Jamie Clark** making his first stepladder appearance against the reigning “bowler of the year” **Dan Bock**. A split in the middle of the game by Clark and a late four-bagger by Bock had Bock winning the match 246-194. **Rob Downer** was up next for Bock and this time Bock had the split in the middle of the game while Downer had the last 6 to win 235-204. Downer ran into Langer and didn’t fare too “*Well Well Well*” as Langer had the front 6 on his way to a 249-176 victory.

**Rob Downer** was a “*Working Class Hero*” as he led all 49 bowlers in qualifying by shooting 1925 (240 avg) for the 8 games while it took 1689 (211 avg) to cash and make the top 16 cut. **Jeff Walther & Ron Lindner** tried not to start a “*Revolution*” as they tied for 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> and had to have a 1 game rolloff to see who would move on. Walther won 227-190 and Lindner ended up with the Bonus Senior Cash Spot and **Tracey Magnuson** won the Bonus woman cash spot with 1385. **Jeff Richter** won the 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame eliminator rolloff for the “On Track Casher” and a free entry into the November CBA tournament. **Jason Price & Chris Kurensky** both cashed and made the cut for the first time and **Matt Wratz** had the only honor score with a 300 in the 6<sup>th</sup> game of qualifying.

We have to give thanks to Island Xtreme Bowl’s manager **Scott Maasch** and his staff for hosting a great tournament.
