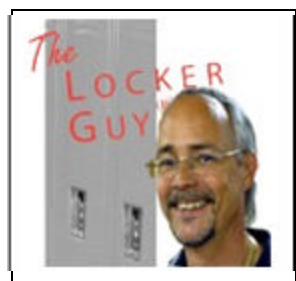
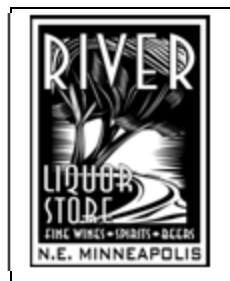

Doug Manhart's First CBA Title is "Major" in Linds Invitational at Drkulas

Doug Manhart picked a great time to win his first CBA title in the Linds Invitational in September at Drkulas. With the added money of \$750.00 from the Linds Shoe Company helping out the total prize fund and this tournament being the 1st leg of the Mike's Pro Shop CBA Points Challenge, Manhart has a leg up on everyone for the extra \$300 for winning the Points Challenge. "Major" Manhart dominated the stepladder as he averaged 249 for the 4 stepladder games. Bowling against the tournament leader and first time stepladder finalist **Henry Trutwin** in the championship match, Manhart had strikes in 7 of the first 8 frames. Trutwin had a little trouble striking and could only manage a 197 as Manhart shot 247 for the win and his first CBA title. Trutwin led all match play bowlers in average with a 247 and won 7 matches to be the leader going into the match play.

Manhart took on last years' Rookie of the Year, **Jamie Clark** in the first stepladder match and needed to mark in the 10th to win 215-202. He then took on **Sam Sylvester Jr** and didn't give Sam much of a chance as he had the front seven for a 277-223 win. In the semifinal match Manhart had to face the current point leader and CBA Hall of Famer, **David Langer** and he again started with the front seven and finished with a 257-214 victory.

Doug Manhart was the Saturday Qualifying Leader as he shot 2494 (249 avg) for the 10 games. It took a score of 2191 (219 avg) to make the match play as **Sam Sylvester Jr** and **Dave Oulman** had to have a 1 game rolloff to break the tie and Sylvester won 200-187 as Oulman took the last cash spot. **Dave Bordson**, bowling in his first CBA as a senior took the Bonus Senior Cash Spot with a score of 2139 (213 avg) and **Kayla Stram** won the Bonus Woman cash spot.
